SPANISH 1 Grade: 9-12

Length: 1 semester

Credit: .5 Fee: No

Prerequisite: None

**Course Description:** Spanish 1 introduces students to the specific culture and to the four basic language skills: listening comprehension, speaking, reading, and writing. Students will acquire skills through oral repetition, dialogue, short composition, dictation, reading, and written exercises.

### **SPANISH 2**

**Grade:** 9-12

Length: 1 Semester

Credit: .5 Fee: No

Prerequisite: Spanish 1

**Course Description:** Spanish 2 furthers the study of grammar, vocabulary, and an understanding of the culture through movies, videos, magazines, and literature. Student will improve listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. Students will begin to develop reading comprehension skills through short stories, plays, and poetry.

#### SPANISH 3 and 4

**Grade:** 9-12

Length: 1 Semester

Credit: .5 Fee: No

Prerequisite: Spanish 1/Spanish 2

**Course Description:** Spanish 3 and 4 reviews basic grammatical structures and continues the study of grammar, vocabulary, and culture. Students will further develop skills in understanding reading, speaking, and writing through short stories, poetry, articles, oral presentation, and written exercises. Students will read a novel in the second language.

#### **FRENCH 1**

Prerequisite: None

## RUSSIAN 1 Grade: 9-12

Length: 1 Semester

Credit: .5 Fee: No

Prerequisite: None

**Course Description:** Russian 3 and 4 reviews basic grammatical structures and continues the study of grammar, vocabulary, and culture. Students will further develop skills in understanding reading, speaking, and writing through short stories, poetry, articles, oral presentation, and written exercises.

# SUGT'STUN 1

**Grade:** 9-12

Length: 1 Semester

Credit: .5 Fee: No

Prerequisite: None

**Course Description:** Sugt'stun 1 is an introduction to the Sugt'stun alphabet (a total of 28 sounds/letters) and students will learn up to 500 high frequency sight words. Cultural understanding of words and specific attributes that define Sugpiaq culture will be introduced and explored.

### **SUGT'STUN 2**

**Grade:** 9-12

**Length:** 1 Semester

Credit: .5 Fee: No

Prerequisite: Sugt'stun 1

**Course Description:** Sugt'stun 2 reinforces the vocabulary taught in Level 1. Students will learn basic stems, verbs, and nouns, and be able to add the appropriate endings. Students will continue to develop their reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills. Cultural understanding of words and specific attributes that define Sugpiaq culture will be further explored.
