### Obligations/Contributions

Health care obligations and contributions provide employee and employer amounts of health care contributions using different calculation methods.

Obligations are estimates of funds that employees and the district will be obligated to contribute, based on the plan year (July through June).

Returning employees are covered by the health care plan for the entire plan year, meaning the 12 month period July through June; both employee and employer are obligated to pay for 12 months of coverage. New employees pay for coverage from date of hire through June, the end of the plan year. If an employee works at all during a month, both employee and employer pay for the entire month of coverage.

Actual Contributions made by employees and benefits paid by the employer during the payroll process are shown on the sheet in the columns labeled "Collected." The division of payments is governed by the Collective Bargaining Agreements and Memorandums of Understanding between the district and the employee groups.

Employee-paid contributions are deductions from payroll checks. Employees who work 12 months make contributions each pay period. Many school district employees do not work 12 months, so contributions are collected for those employees during the 9 month period from September through May.

For this reason, contributions are generally larger than obligations for September through May and contributions are generally smaller than obligations for June, July and August.

The "Collected" columns show what is actually available for paying health care costs. The "Obligations" show what is estimated to be available by month, based on number of employees at the current rate of contributions.

2. **Prescription drug change – Require use of the Caremark Specialty Prescription network and implement the Specialty Copay Card Program.**

Participants would be required to use Caremark’s specialty mail pharmacy. This provides an additional level of oversight on the medication fills and refills, as well as additional participant support. The Specialty Copay Card Program would allow participants to take advantage of manufacturer copay assistance programs (thus reducing the participant cost) without a negative cost impact to the plan. Estimated savings = \$12,000

3. **Prescription drug change – Lower the dollar threshold on prior authorizations for compound medications from \$500 per script to \$300 per script; Minimal savings**

4. **Apply PPO differentials on all services, in all areas.** PPO providers are reimbursed at 80% of covered charges. Non-PPO providers would be reimbursed at 60% of covered charges. Encourages participants to use PPO providers when possible.

For additional incentive, the plan may wish to set the allowable expense for non-PPO providers at 150% of Medicare.

Need additional data to evaluate savings. Will provide calculation if KPBSD is interested in reviewing this change.

Hearing Aid Options**

**Common Plan Designs**

- **Coinsurance (eg. 80%) up to a dollar limit**
  - **Some plans have a minimal benefit (eg \$400 to \$800)**
  - **Some plans are \$3,000 or \$5,000 (both ears)**
  - **PEHT does not specify a dollar limit**
- **Some plans reduce the coinsurance at some point. For example, 80% up to \$600 each ear and then 50% up to \$2,500.**
- **The benefit frequency is limited to every 3 years or every 36 months**

**Not including the limited (\$400 to \$800) benefit plans, the cost ranges from \$2.50 PEPM to \$7 PEPM.**

Laser Eye Surgery**

- Cost generally varies from \$1,500 - \$2,500 per eye. The cost will vary depending on correction needed, the technology used, and by provider.
- Health plans which offer coverage typically provide an allowance of \$500 to \$1,000.
- VSP typically offers a discount of 15-20%.

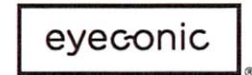
