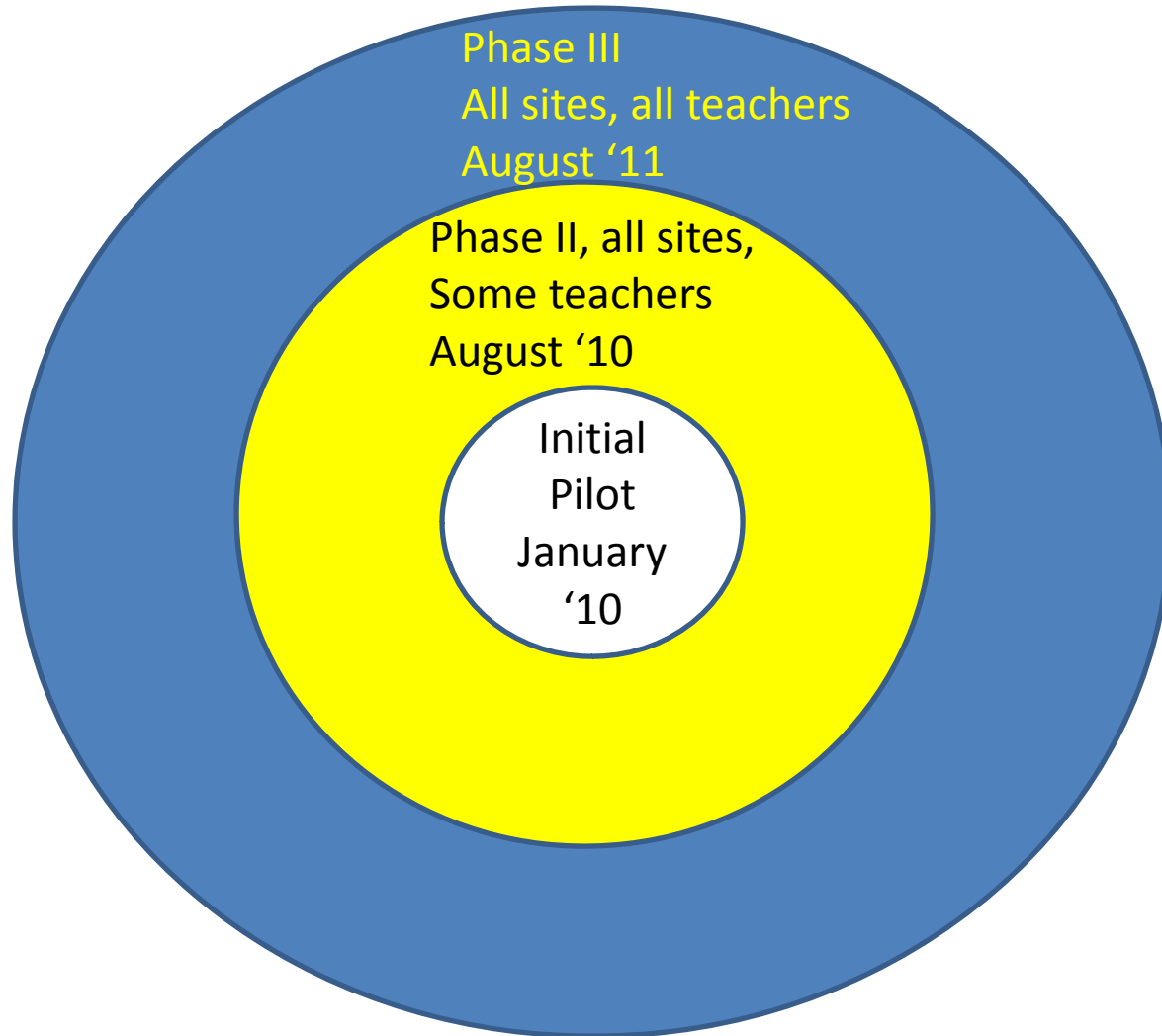

New Teacher Evaluation System

- Framework (Danielson)
- 4 Domains (planning and preparation, classroom environment, professional responsibilities, instruction)
 - 22 components, 74 elements
- Better design to promote teacher growth
- Four tiers of placement- unsatisfactory, basic, proficient, distinguished
- Training in June on inter-rater reliability
- Pilot right now with ten principals-next training in April
- All principals will use system in August but with only part of their staff
- All teachers evaluated under this system starting in August 2011

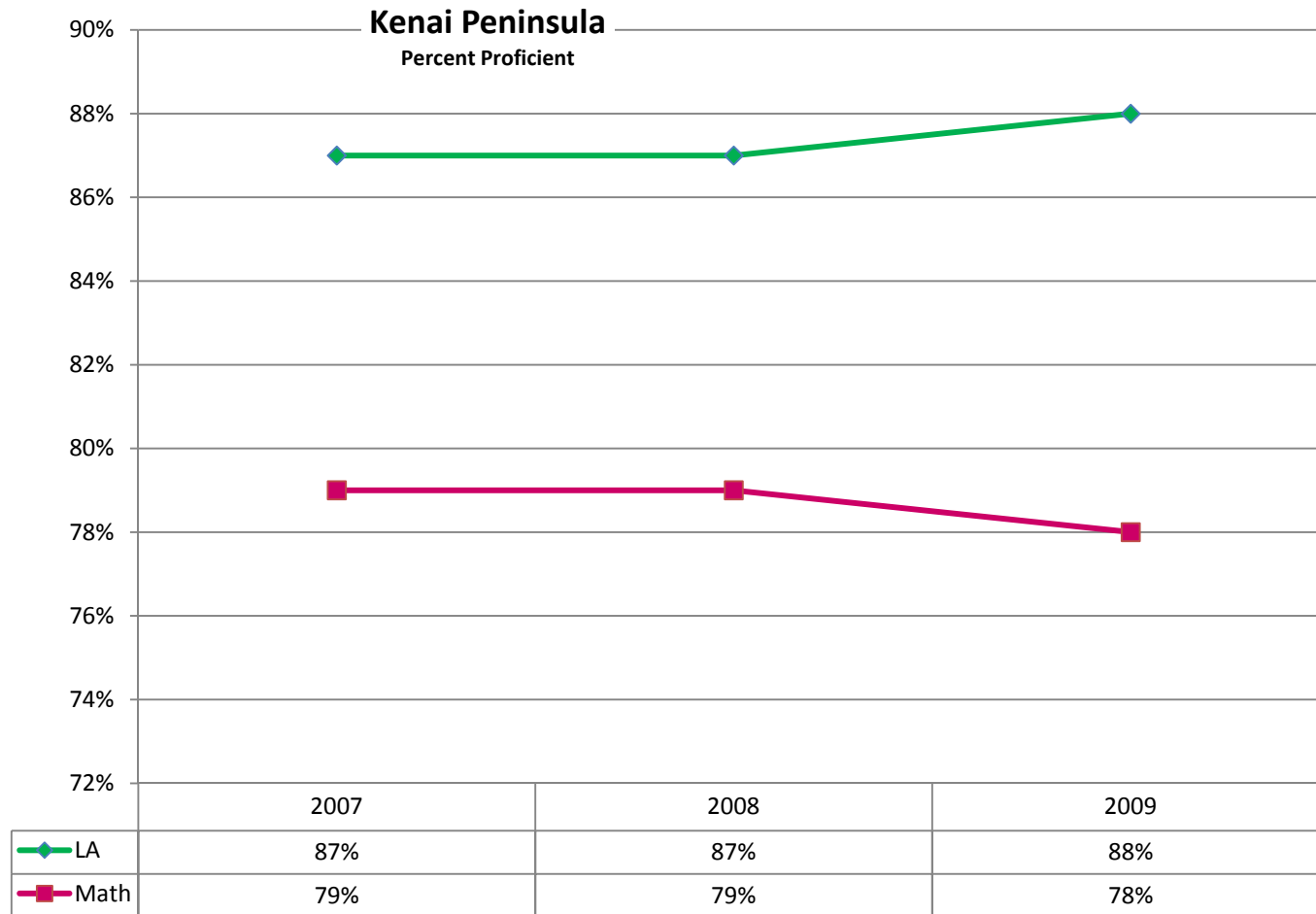

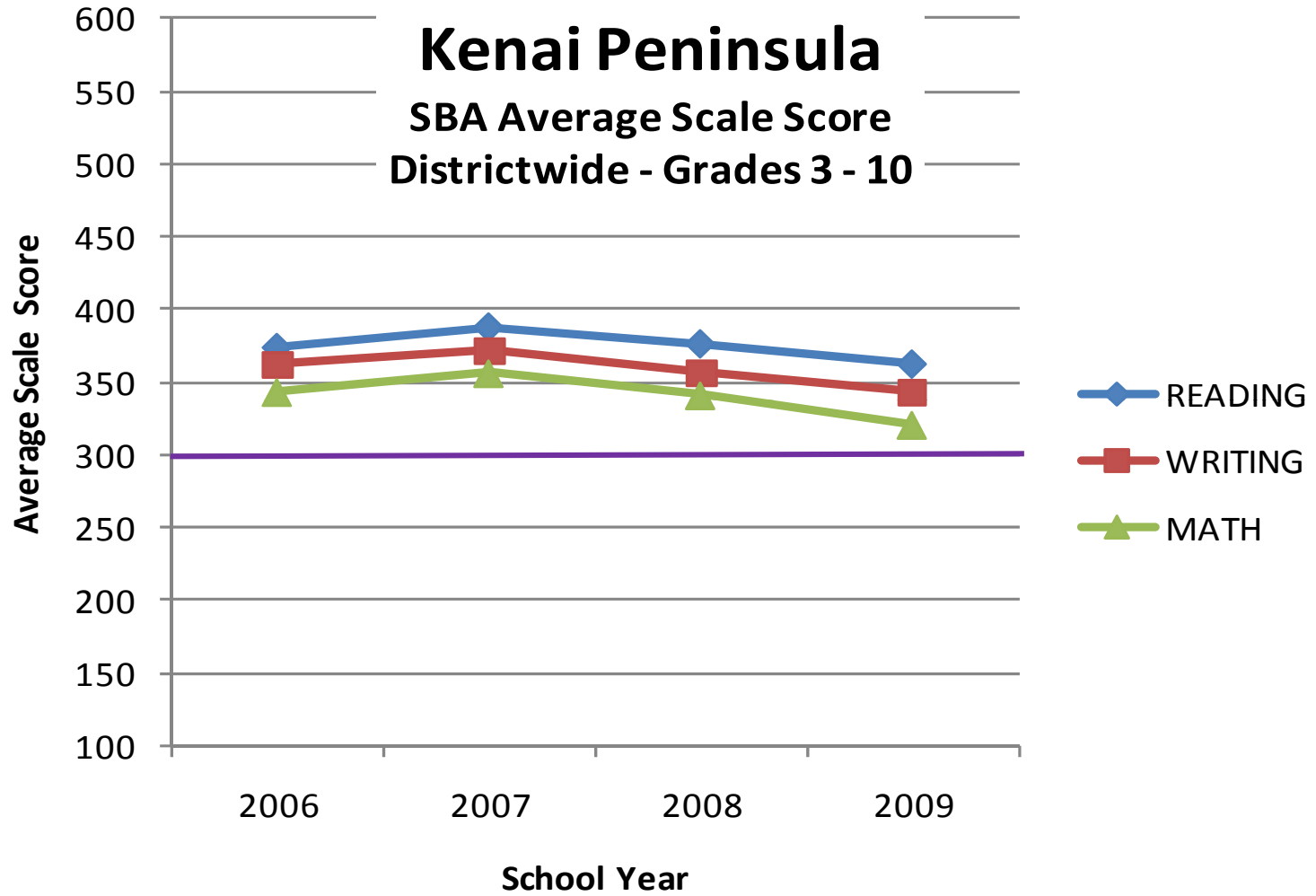
SBA Proficiency Trend Data



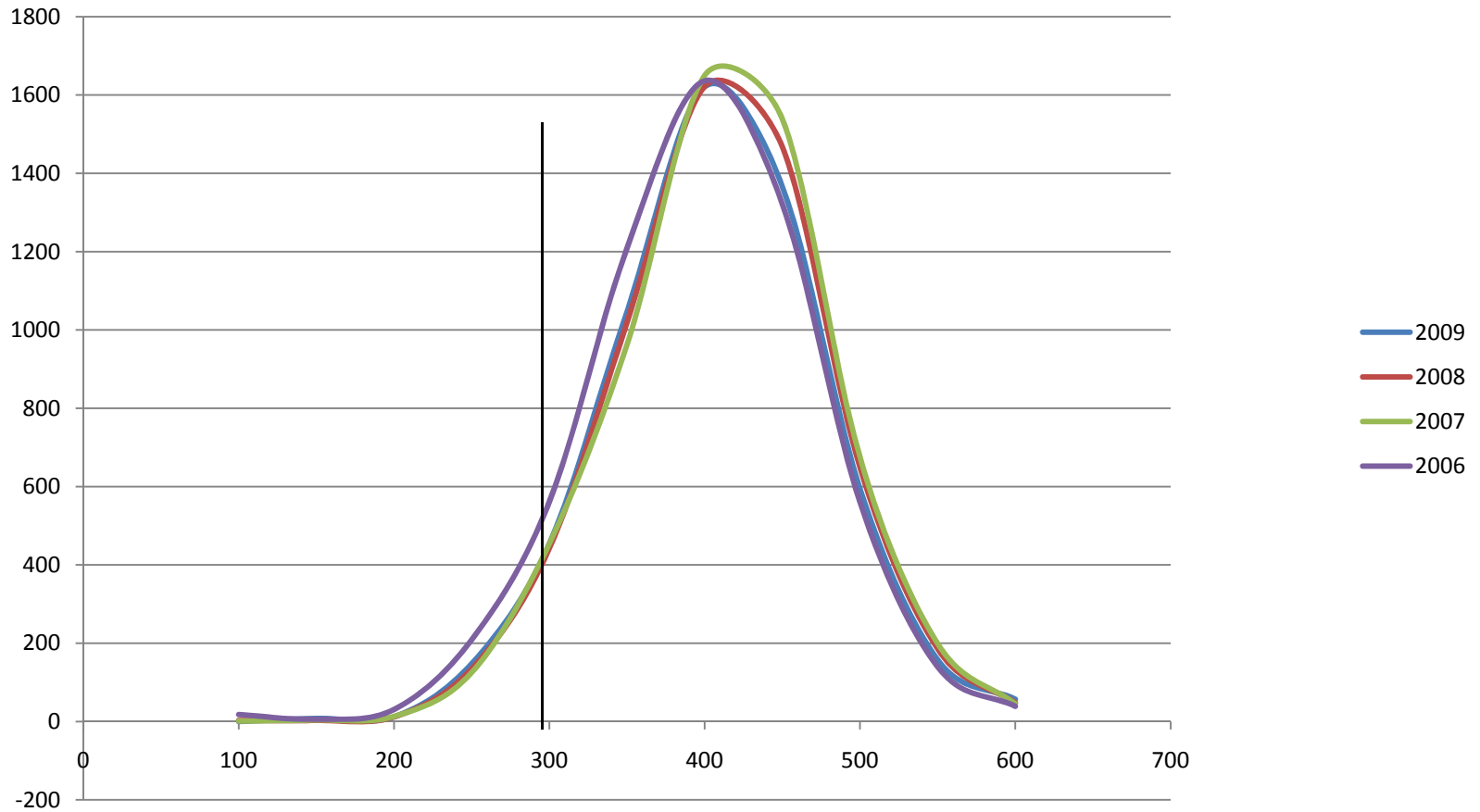
Kenai Peninsula

SBA Average Scale Score

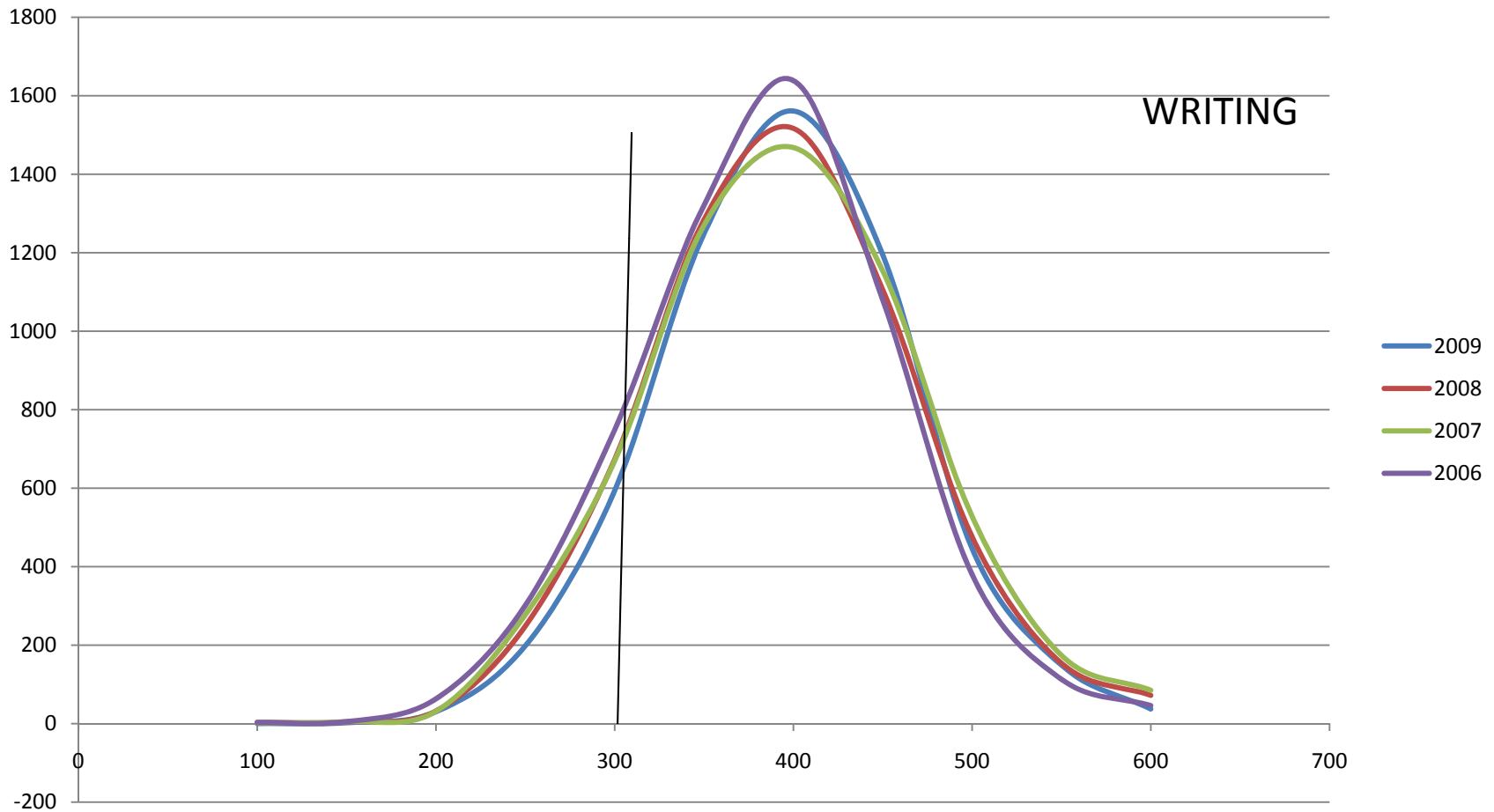
Districtwide - Grades 3 - 10



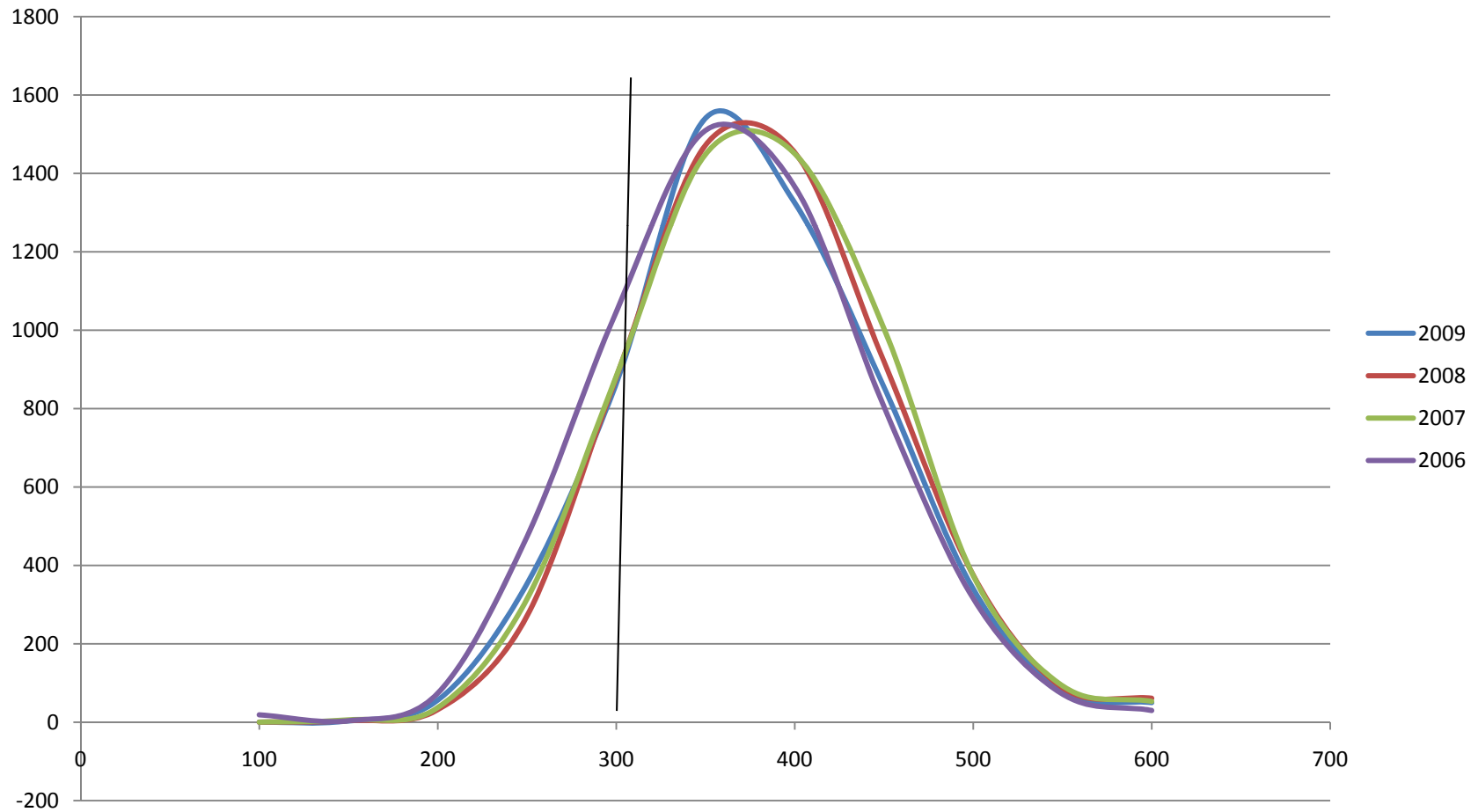
Distribution of 2006-09 SBA Reading Scores



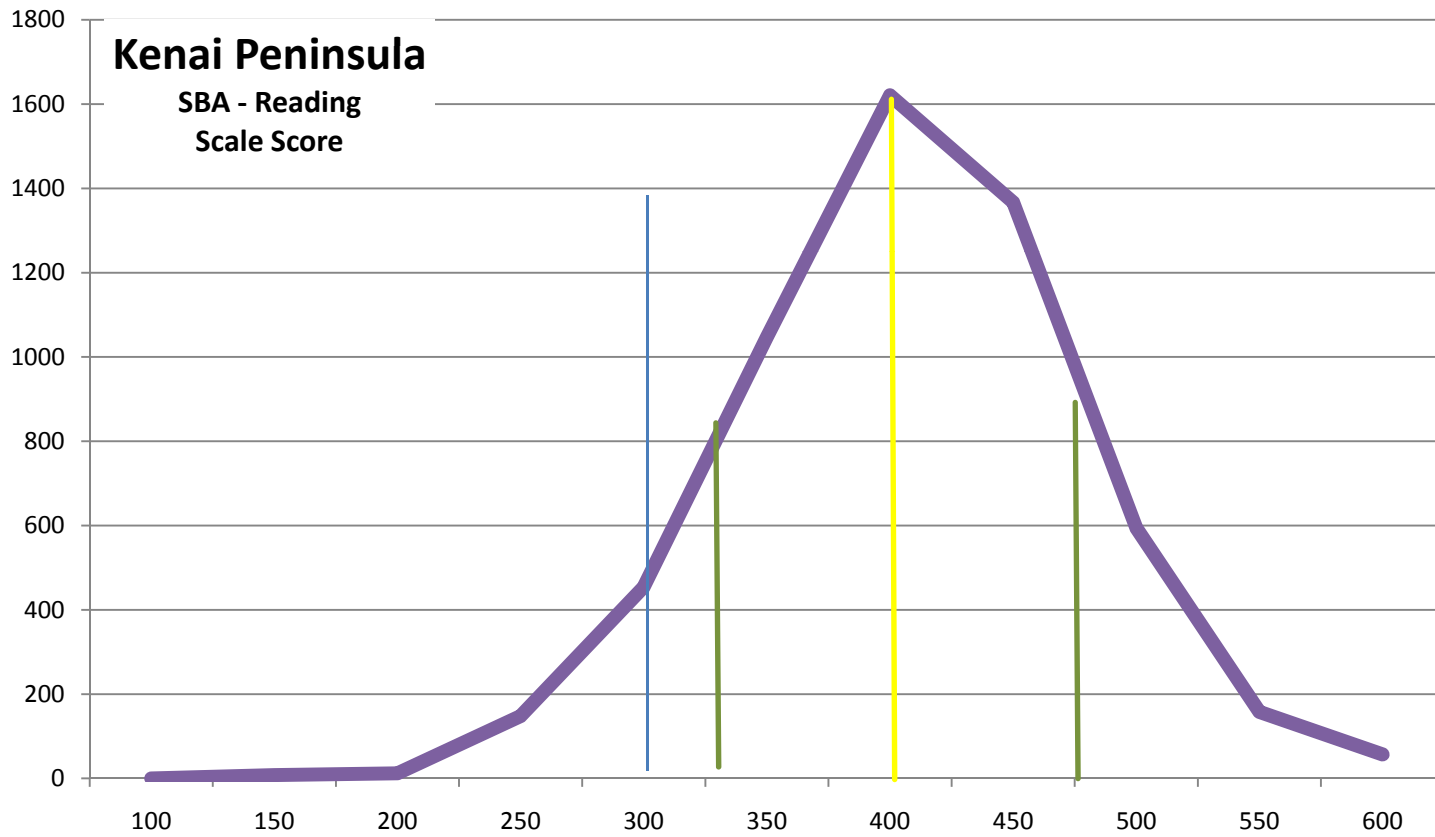
Distribution of 2006-09 SBA Writing Scores



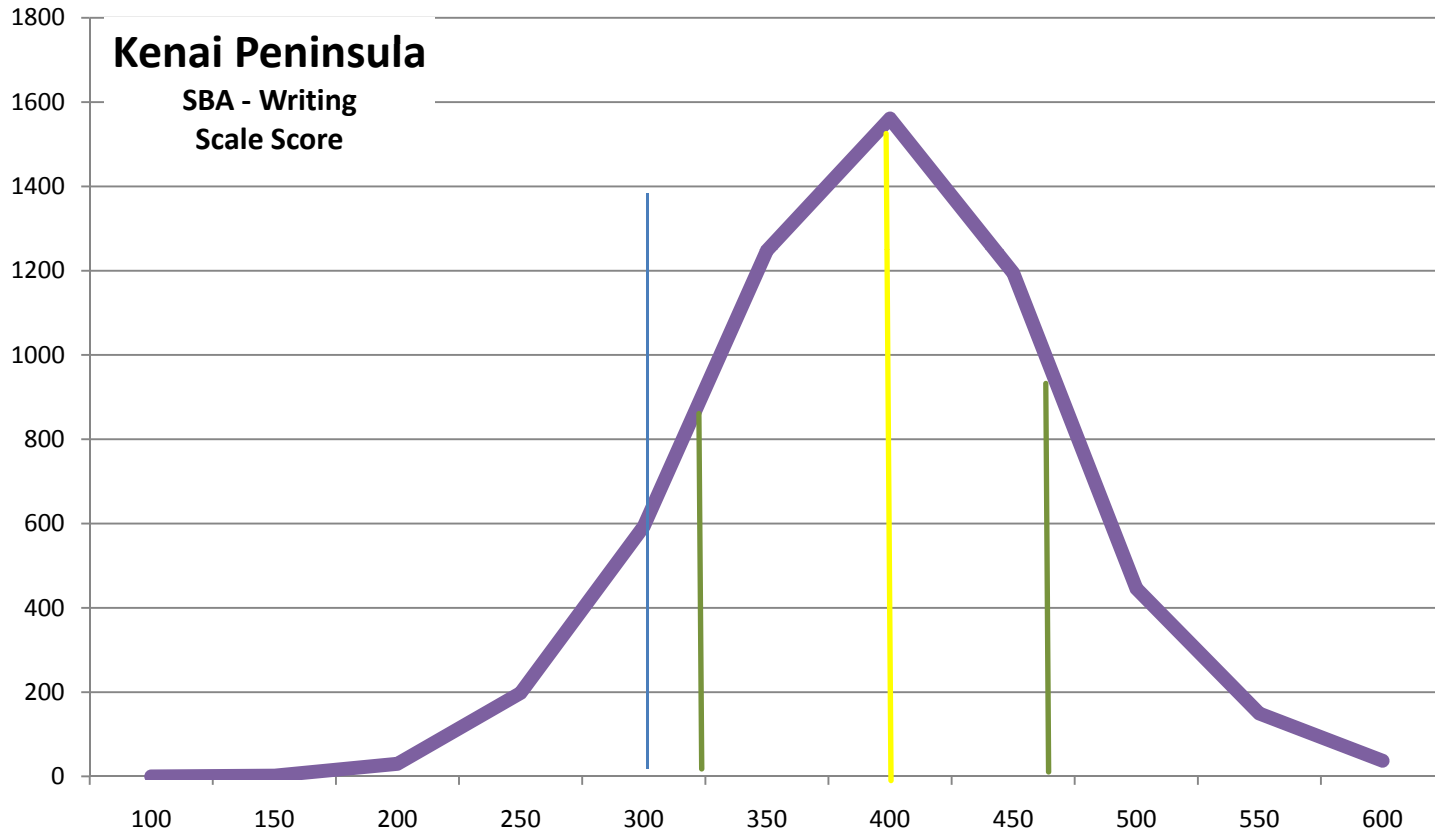
Distribution of 2006-09 SBA Math Scores



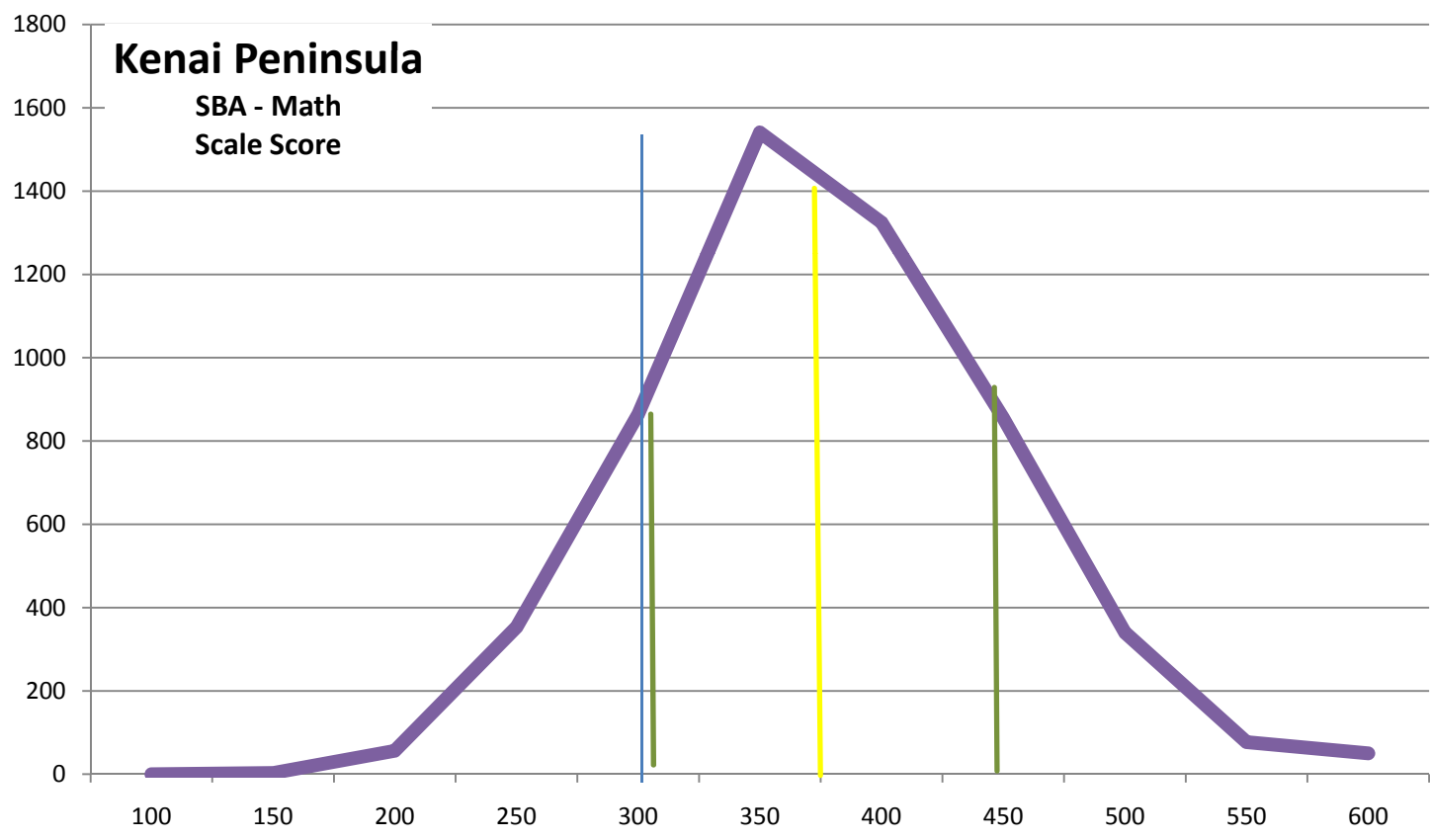
2009 KPBSD READING SBA DISTRIBUTION
