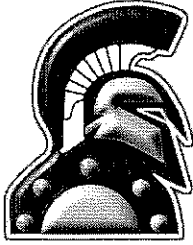
Dear Human Resources Department,

Mr. Peterson:


