

Kenai Peninsula Borough School District / Fireweed Academy Charter School
Sharing Facilities Contract Addendum
2006/-2007

The Kenai Peninsula Borough School District and Fireweed Academy Charter School Academic Policy Committee agree to this Contract Addendum regarding sharing facility space for the 2007-2008 school year.

1. Room Usage and Operational Costs

- A. The enrollment at Fireweed Academy Charter School will not exceed 90 students at West Homer Elementary School.
- B. The District will provide 5 classrooms at West Homer Elementary School.
- C. The District will provide Room 214 for an office area at West Homer Elementary School for the 2007-2008 school year.
- D. Fireweed Academy will pay the District approximately \$50,100 to cover the pro-rated operational cost associated with sharing a district facility for the 2007-2008 school year (utilities, shared staff, shared supplies, etc.).

- D. Common Areas: Use and scheduling of the gym and music room will be pro-rated according to the percentage of students attending Fireweed Academy compared to the West Homer Elementary School population. The enrollment projections for 2007-2008 indicate the pro-rated amount is West Homer -73% and Fireweed -27%.
 - I. Gym- ten 30 minute periods per week (5 hours)
 - II. Music Room- ten 30 minute periods per week (5 hours)
 - III. Art- the equivalent of ten 30 minute periods per week or 8 weeks per year
 - IV. Other – Fireweed and West Homer will work cooperatively to accommodate special events by either program in these shared spaces

2. Fireweed Academy Administrator

- A. Administrator responsibilities involve the management of all daily operations of Fireweed Academy. Student achievement will match or exceed District goals and State standards.
- B. The administrator shall maintain fiscal management according to District guidelines and State Statutes. This includes the preparation and oversight of the school's budget, with regular accountability to, and approval of, the APC.
- C. The administrator will be the official liaison between the District administration, the APC and the charter school. Frequent open and regular communication will be maintained with the neighborhood school administrator to insure a successful relationship.
