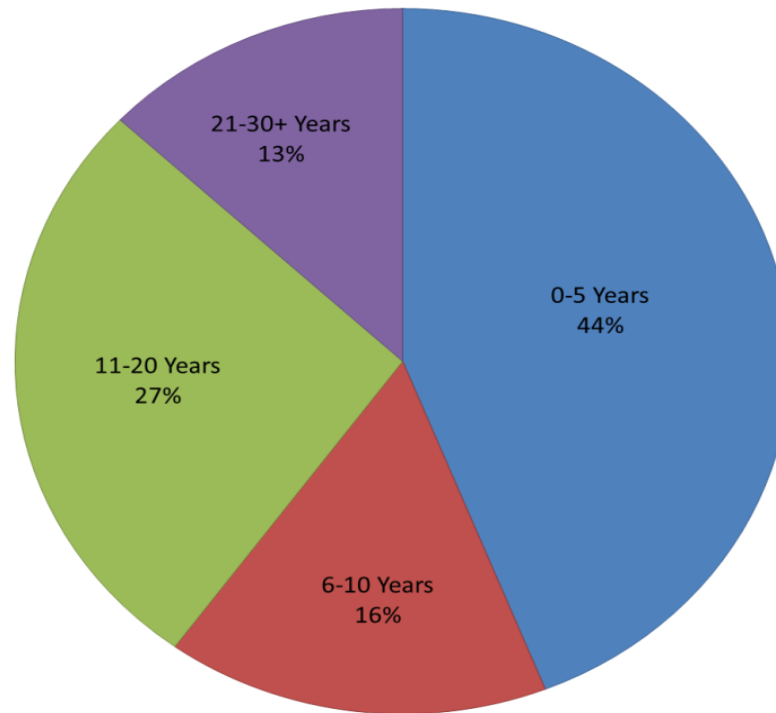

# Where is KPBSD going?

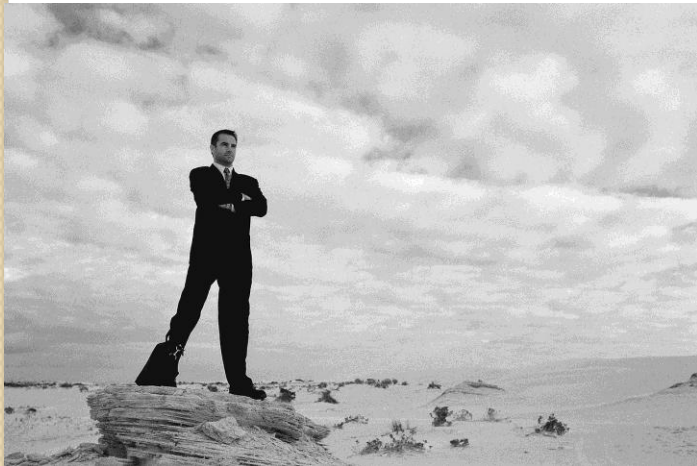
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- My stretch goal is for KPBSD to be a world class school district.

- The KPBSD Board will support and participate in the District Communication Strategic Plan

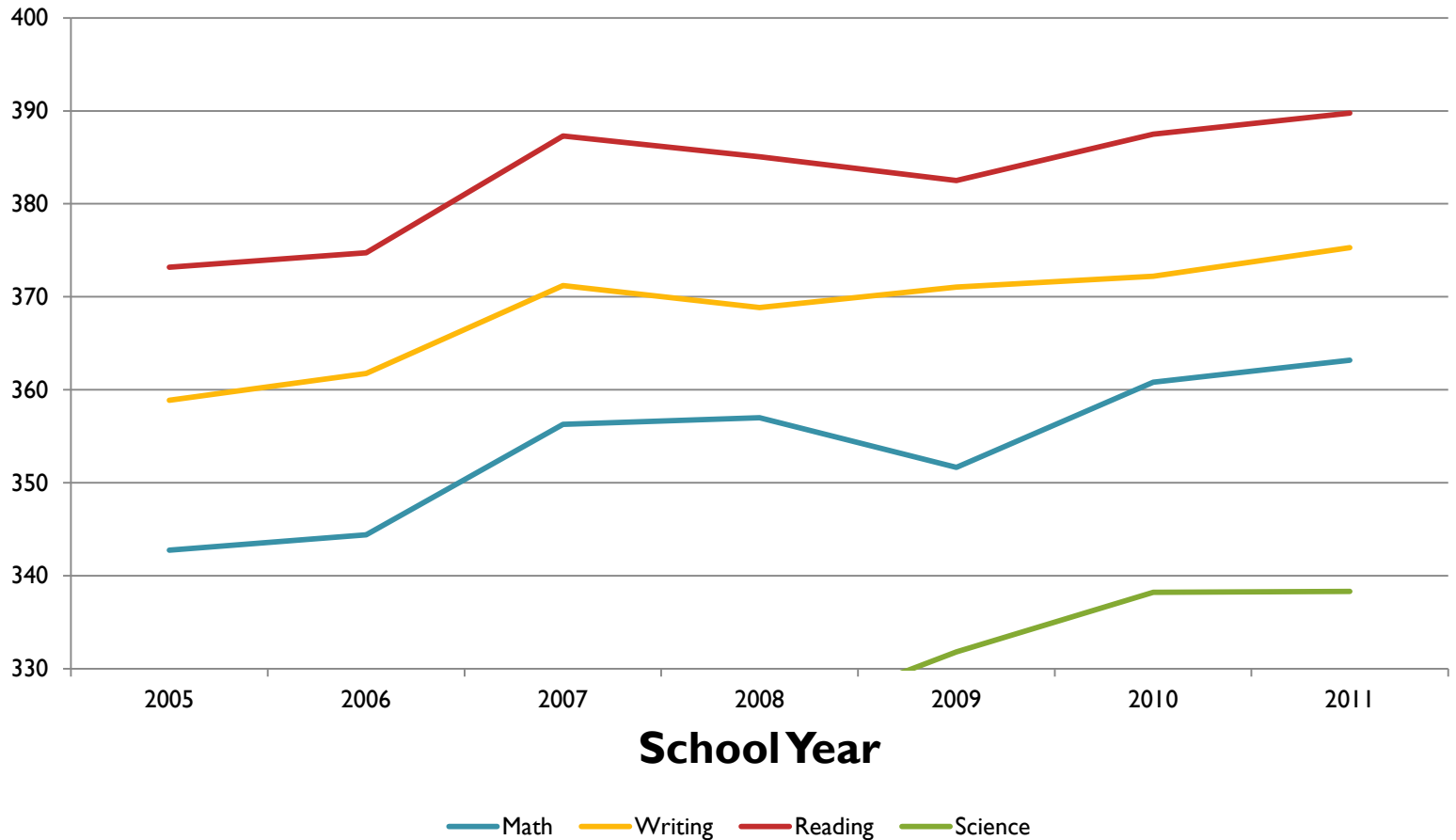
# Last April's SBA results-we're headed in the right direction

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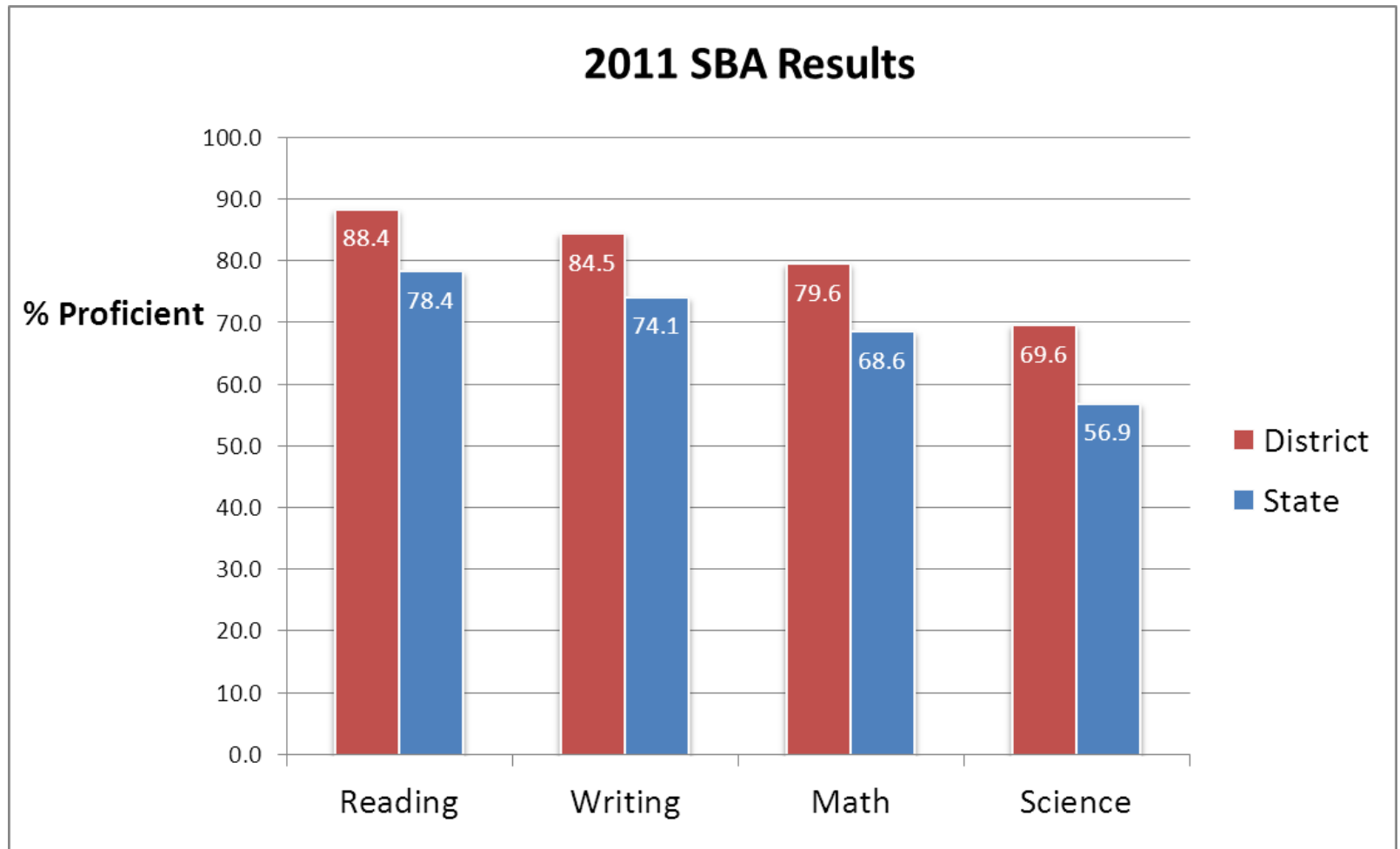
- Average Scale Score inched up in reading, writing and math

## SBA Scale Score Averages 2005 - 2011

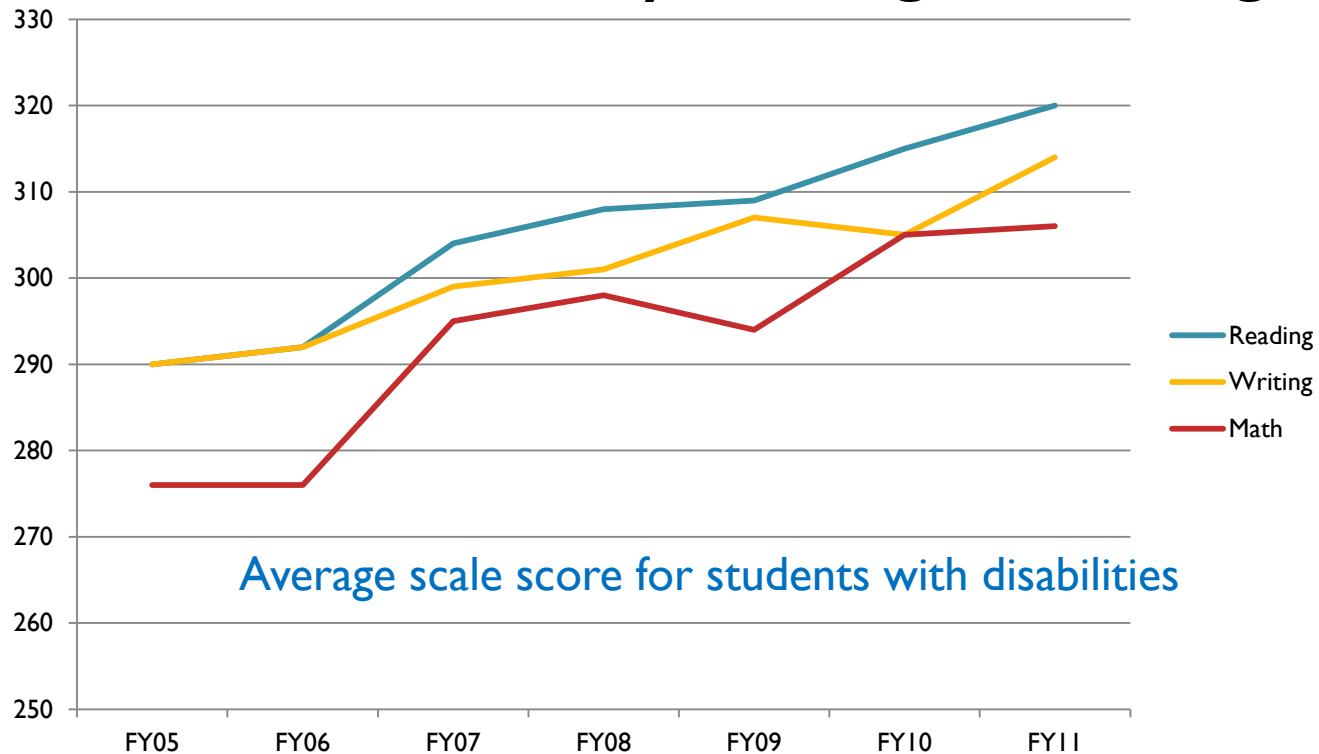


# Comparison of % of KPBSD Students Proficient or Advanced with Alaska's Students



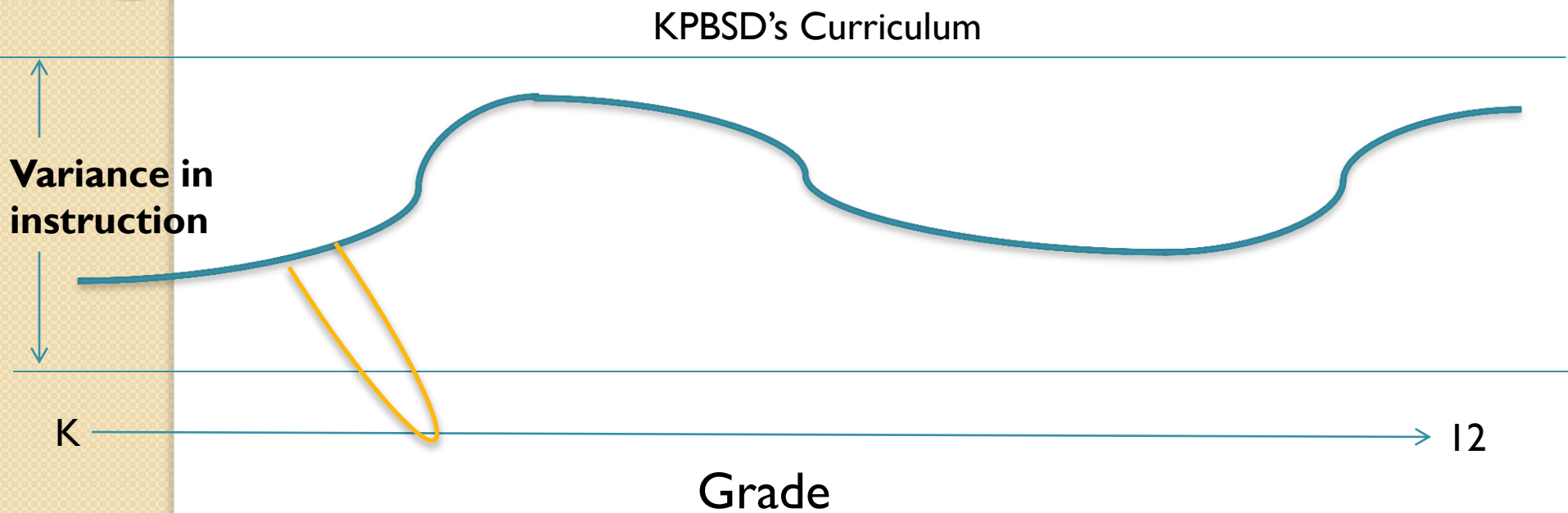
# Adequate Yearly Progress
