**SCHOOL REPORT:** Ms. Carolyn Cannava, Soldotna Elementary Principal, showed a presentation on Literacy Centers. It included video clips from teaching sessions at the school and various graphs which noted student CBM charts. Ms. Cannava presented parent, Debbie Carroll and her daughter Gracie. Gracie is a 2<sup>nd</sup> grader at Soldotna Elementary. Gracie did a reading from the Dr. Seuss book, “The places you’ll go”, to demonstrated her increased CBM level.
