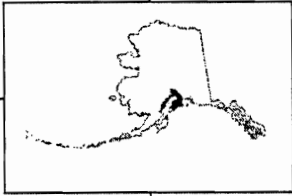


Please accept this as a formal letter of resignation from KPBSD. I




