**WORKSESSION REPORT:** The Board held several worksessions prior to the formal business meeting which included the bond referendum; proposed AASB Resolutions; District goals; new standards for Performance-based Schools; and the Adequate Yearly Progress Results.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT:** Dr. Atwater presented the 2009-2010 Superintendent's Annual Report. He announced that preliminary information regarding the curriculum audit has been received and a summary report will be provided to the Board in September. He reported that the District received a notice that the Title program allocation has been lowered by \$138,000 due to the elimination of the Title IV Program.

**FINANCIAL REPORT:** Mr. Jones presented the financial report of the District for the period ending July 31, 2010.

**QUARTERLY BUDGET REPORT:** Mr. Jones reported on budget transfers Numbers 938 through 1551 for various schools and departments within the District.

**SUBSTITUTE AND TEMPORARY PAY SCHEDULE:** The Board unanimously approved the pay schedule for substitutes and other temporary employees for the 2010-2011 school year.

**NONTENURE TEACHER CONTRACTS:** The Board unanimously approved nontenure teacher contracts for Eric P. Knudtson, (temporary) technology coach, Homer Area Schools; Holly D. **NEW TEACHER CONTRACTS:** The Board unanimously approved teacher contracts for Trina Uvaas, school psychologist, Central Peninsula Area; Amanda S. Adams, (temporary) technology coach, Central Peninsula & Seward Area; Stephanie D. Belger, primary grade teacher, Redoubt Elementary; Sarah N. Swaney, special education intensive needs teacher, Soldotna High School; Thomas F. Cavanaugh, intermediate grade teacher, Sterling Elementary; Bethany J. Nyboer, special education resource teacher, Sterling Elementary; Amanda Painter, primary grade teacher, Tustumena Elementary; and Robert F. Thompson II, special education resource teacher, Voznesenka School.

**POLICY REVISIONS:** The Board unanimously approved the proposed revisions to BP 1250 (Volunteer Assistance), BP 5111 (Admission), and BP 6162.71 (Acceptable Use Policy/Internet Safety Policy).
