Minutes of the PAC Meeting held on November 5, 2021 via Zoom

Tommy opened the meeting at 5:15 pm and asked for approval of the agenda.

Approval of Agenda: Heather motioned to approve the agenda as written. Virginia seconded and the motion passed.

Review and Approval of Minutes: Virginia motioned to approve the minutes of the last meeting (August 12, 2021) as written. Heather seconded and the motion passed.

Principal's Report: Mr. Hayman was going to make a video for tonight's meeting, but he had to attend a field trip and will send it later. There have been some updates to the district's COVID protocol that he wants to share. Tommy will send it via email when he receives it.

Teacher's Report:

- Swags – The swags should be in Soldotna by November 22. We will have to figure out how to get them to Cooper Landing and get them assembled and out the door before Thanksgiving break.
- Skiing – Skiing has been approved by the administration. Moose Pass and Hope School will be going as well. Alyeska's mitigation plan will be similar to last year's, except this year there will be one restaurant open.

The price per student has gone up to \$160 which includes lessons and lift tickets. We will be going on Tuesdays starting sometime in January and finishing up in March. Lessons will be from 1:30-3:30 and then free skiing until 5:30.

Virginia asked about the PAC paying for skiing since we haven't done any fundraising. Last year the PAC paid, and in past years, sometimes parents have chipped in.

Discussion ensued and it was decided that the PAC will pay the entire amount this year. Fundraising will have to be done for next year. Motion by Heather to have the PAC pay the entire amount. The motion was seconded by Rachel and the motion passed.

Tommy will have more information about skiing later this month. We will send home paperwork for parents to fill out before Christmas break.

Tommy emphasized that if anyone wants to go on the skiing trips or drive kids other than their own, they must complete the volunteer background check on the KPBSD website. It can be found [here](#).
