 Meetings. No concrete numbers or info. Tangible action item: reach out to Borough

 one liner, quick.

School will have Title 1 Funds next year. If pupil:teacher ratios change in the district, it will not impact ratio at FW since we have set class size in charter. COULD impact FW if tenured teachers are cut from other district schools, they could displace FW non-tenured teachers.

Goal of district is to have \$4 million surplus to refill the hail mary account.

IDEA: postcard campaign for borough, FW logo one side, have them available at LFW pick up for parents to fill out if they want.

• Mo: Does Bunnell have money for Artist in the Schools or will LFW need \$ from FoFA: Bunnell has \$ and will cover artist and match supply budget.

- Greta: Shirts and Bags (people at meeting looked over the shirt options: Adult shirts: purple frost, ½ white ½ clear ink, red frost red frost same ink choices. Kids: red frost and blue frost). People liked the large green totes. Kyle and Allison suggest VistaPrint may have more affordable bag options, people like the shirts we've been getting and will stay with Ink to Press for shirts.
- Anyone: One Campus- committed group gathering steam. No details reported due to time constraints.

1. Peony Fundraiser:

- 2024 total sales: \$1,713, minus the cost of supplies (-\$1,043.50), total of \$669.50 for FWA
- Allison from the peony co-op: FW has done 2 fundraisers, FW gets items at wholesale and FW keeps the profit.
- Google Form for the order
- Tessa made some fliers- we can add QR codes/work w Leah from the peony co-op to get the google order form linked up w QR code so people can pay directly to FoFA when the order is placed.

2. HoWL DirtBag Clean Up April 21-26, all around town and the beaches

- Molly from HoWL connected to the meeting by speaker phone
- Allison G is willing to make a "Team FW" of 6th graders and ask businesses: 2 Sisters. Homer's Jeans, Allison will get kids out a few days next week.
- Kids age 8+ can do clean up with a HoWL chaperone, if <8, kids need a family member to go with them on the clean ups
- 3:30-5:30 after school, snacks provided by HoWL, WHE kids could walk to Bishop's meet up after school, get a snack, then participate in the clean up
- <u>HoWL Pledge sheets</u> can we add a Fireweed Logo on the ones our students use to collect pledges?
 - When/how is \$ collected: one way: if you fill out the form for pledges (can say the group has a set goal # bags-maybe 1.5-2 bags/day =40-50 bag goal for the school) participate in the event, after clean up week kids return to pledgers and tell how much was collected.
 - Participation waivers needed for each student can do at the event or electronic waiver option (Molly will send out to FW)

- Safety talk given daily before clean up: Gloves and picker uppers are provided, no collection of sharps, no trash collection in the roadways
 - Can we make a QR code for 6th grade \$ to FoFA
 - Add FoFA logo on the top of the page -can add a blurb about FW adventure

3. Beautification Day, Spring Planning: April 26, 27 with follow up, as needed May 3, 4 LFW

- Time: 10am-3pm- give options both Saturday and Sunday, outdoor work can be done any time, building will be open for indoor work 10a-3pm. (people to open and close the school)
