Cars on Campus Policy

Driving a vehicle to school is considered a privilege **not** a right. All students driving vehicles to school and during school hours are expected to have a valid driver's license and state mandated vehicle insurance. Proof of insurance is required before a student may drive on campus. The privilege to drive on campus will be revoked and the proper authorities will be contacted if there are any infractions of these laws. In addition, the privilege will be revoked if the driver is observed repeatedly demonstrating unsafe driving practices on, **or off**, campus. Please discuss with your student the potential financial risk for you and your family if he/she were to be involved in an accident with an uninsured driver.

INSURANCE NOTICE

Alaska law requires the owner of operator of a vehicle to have liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$50,000/\$100,000 for bodily injury or death and \$25,000 for property damage. Failure to have the required insurance may result in a suspension of your driving privileges for 90 days or more.

The law requires you to carry proof of insurance in your vehicle.
