Homer High School serves approximately 360 students in grades 9-12 from Homer, AK (pop. 5,500) and the surrounding area. Primary local industries are hospitality and tourism, commercial fishing, and maritime trades. The academic calendar consists of two semesters on a 6-period modified block schedule. HHS is one of 42 schools within Kenai Peninsula Borough School District, which educates approximately 9,000 students in grades Pre-K-12th over a wide, largely rural geographical area (25,000 sq. mi.).
