PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES

- Follow ASAA mitigation plans for events and soccer under the low risk category
- Outdoor events – spectators limited to what the facility can handle with emphasis on social distancing of at least 6 feet
 - Bleachers will be taped at 6 foot intervals to encourage social distancing
 - Signage will be provided with guidelines for social distancing

SCREENING

- Prior to attending, advisors, coaches, supervisors, and participants must sign a waiver of liability related to COVID-19
 - Athletic Waivers can be found on kpbsd.org COVID website. Coaches, Players, & Supervisors must sign waiver paper copy,
- Skyview will be expected to adhere to the protocols and screen athletes before they get on the bus, record the information and be prepared to give Homer Administration their personnel checklist including the bus driver.
- Screen advisors, coaches, supervisors, participants, and officials prior to each session. Includes a temperature check, questions, and phone number/email. Information should be recorded and stored to help facilitate contact tracing of a confirmed exposure.
- Anyone with a temperature of greater than 100.0 degrees or with positive symptoms reported will not be allowed to participate, should self-isolate, and contact their primary care provider or other health-care professional.
- **Spectators will not be screened but must wear masks to enter the gate.**
- There will be a designated individuals on site responsible for monitoring and following all screening, cleaning, and social distancing protocols; capacity will be capped at 250 spectators; gate attendants will inform HMS administrators when 150 capacity is reached.

FACILITY CLEANING

- Cleaning and disinfecting will be conducted in compliance with CDC protocols
 - Custodial staff from Homer High School will be used for the event

FACILITY AND EQUIPMENT

- **A minimum of (3) sanitized back-up game balls should be available from each team**
- Facility will have signage of cleaning and COVID protocols and visual indicators of proper spacing between individuals
- Hand sanitizer will be available to all participants and spectators
- Permanent toilets will be used for the event
 - One person at a time; lines will be monitored and social distancing markers will be utilized; high touch surfaces will be sanitized hourly; COVID protocols posted on doors
- Skyview athletes will not have access to locker rooms
- Homer Athletes must arrive dressed to compete and return home to shower
- Hydration stations will not be used
 - All athletes must have their own water bottles
- Each team is responsible for its own towels, hand sanitizer, and med kit (no sharing will be permitted.)

INDIVIDUAL HYGIENE

- Concessions will not be offered.

INDIVIDUAL HYGIENE

- All event workers are required to wear masks
- All workers, participants, coaches, administrators, and spectators are encourage to wash hands for a minimum of 20 seconds with warm water and soap or hand sanitizer before touching any surfaces or participating in competition
- Appropriate clothing/shoes should be worn at all times to minimize sweat from transmitting onto equipment/surfaces
- Athletes should report in appropriate attire and immediately return home to shower after participation
- Encourage the practice of sneezing or coughing into a tissue, or on the inside of the elbow. Avoid touching the face.
- All athletes must have their own water bottle. Water bottles and food must not be shared.
- All individuals must refrain from handshakes, high fives, fist/elbow bumps, group celebrations, etc.

FACE COVERINGS

- Cloth face covering by participants should be used when not engaging in vigorous activity, Soccer protocols are that all athletes should have 6 feet of social distancing while on the sidelines.
- Participants will be allowed to wear face coverings, if desired.
- Coaches must wear cloth face coverings, especially when physical distancing is not possible
- Officials are strongly encouraged to wear cloth face coverings
- Spectators are strongly encouraged to wear cloth face coverings in low risk
