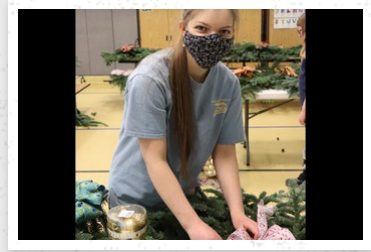
BEING THANKFUL
