## Student report:

**FUNdraising** 

- Pie Sales \$690
- Winter carnival \$288 from bake sale, coffee \$400.
- An additional \$500 is expected for the pie sale as a donation from Jim Gilbert.
- Read-a-thon Starts Feb 1, 2022. The team voted unanimous approval (moved by Jeannine; seconded by Tahneta) for up to \$350 to be spent on two \$50 Barnes and Noble gift cards (most pages read; most money raised) and a pizza party for the school (need to read 10,000 pages as a school). Action items: Tahneta will make the giant thermometer for the school to track pages read; Tahneta will purchase the two \$50 B&N gift cards; Starre will purchase the pizzas, chocolate chip cookies and Capri Suns from Costco when the party is scheduled; Jess volunteered her commercial oven to bake the pizzas for the party.
- There was mention in December by Cherryl Stavish to host a bake sale for Valentine's Day, but that was not confirmed and is TBD.

### New business:

- Rescheduled next meetings due to skiing. Skiing dates: Feb 1, Feb 8, Feb 15, Feb 22, March 1, March 15. Cost per student is \$155, for a grand total of \$3,100. The previously approved PTO amount was \$2,660.00. Board members (via email) discussed and approved additional funds to cover the cost for all students.
