 - i. Oct 2020 at 237 students on site, 50 remote by choice students, 27 K-3 grade students, 23 4-6th grade students= 287 total student population
 - ii. May 2020 at 440 total student population

 - i. Currently staffed based on numbers from last year
 - ii. Concerns that drop in student numbers means risk of losing many staff
 - iii. Counselor position open

4. K-Beach Smart Start Plan
 - a. Shared Smart Start Plan protocols and positive transparent parent feedback.

 - c. Safety measures include but not limited to bussing, increased cleaning, cohorts, education for staff and students made fun for learning, schedules/transitions for cohorts,
