- ❖ **Welcome- sign-in**
- ❖ **Mask Requirements-** Mask requirements was addressed as being a controversial topic and a balance of rights and risks. The school is not wanting to infringe on parent or student rights, but we don't want to risk the health of students or staff.
- ❖ **Social Distancing-** All students will need to have a mask to wear when needed. Students in grades PreK-2 do not need to wear a mask in their classroom, but will need to wear a mask if in a common area, most notably the hallway or bathroom, when not under the direct supervision of their classroom teacher. Students in grades 3-12 need to maintain a six-foot distance from staff and classmates, unless they are siblings, if they are not wearing a mask. If students are receiving help from a teacher or working with a classmate that requires them to be less than 6 feet apart, students will need to wear a mask. When a student moves from their desk, they will need to put on their mask, unless the teacher is able to have students move while maintaining the six foot required distance. While in common areas, most notably the hallway or bathroom, they will be required to wear a mask. At appropriate times during a class period teachers could allow time for anyone who needs to use the restroom, sharpen a pencil, or throw something away, requiring everybody to wear a mask for a short period of time. For student needs during most of the class period passing through someone's bubble for a second isn't considered close contact, meaning only the student initiating the movement would be required to wear the mask. Students will not need to wear a mask outside. Our PreK-2 classes will be separated at recess as will our 3-12 grade students. Students choosing to go into the PED room at recess or those choosing to participate in the Home Ec. class will be required to wear a mask. The PED room will have mixed cohorts and their isn't space to social distance in the Home Ec. class.
- ❖ **Symptom Free** – If your child looks or feels sick, please keep them home. If they come to school and we send them home because they are exhibiting Covid symptoms they are required to be out of school for 10 calendar days and be symptom free for 24 hours, have a negative result from a Covid test, or have a note from a doctor stating that the symptoms are not Covid related.
- ❖ **Increased Handwashing-** Students from PreK-2<sup>nd</sup> grade will experience increased teacher directed handwashing. Students in grades 3-12 will be given frequent reminders from staff to encourage increased handwashing.
- ❖ **Parent/Sub Mask Requirement-** Parents and subs will need to wear a mask the entire time they are in the building, regardless of social distancing.
- ❖ **New Dismissal Time** – Students will now be dismissed at 2:35 instead of the regular dismissal of 3:05. The earlier dismissal will help to accommodate those parents electing the remote learning option. Teachers will have the 2:35-3:05 time to check in with their remote learning students.
- ❖ **Staggered Dismissal at Voznesenka-** Students will be dismissed in five waves, beginning at 2:25. When students get dismissed takes into consideration those students who may/will be carpooling on any given day. It will provide an opportunity to leave the school in a fashion that allows for social distancing.
