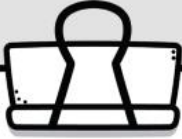

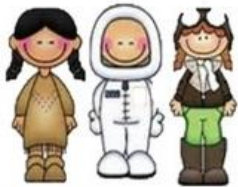


The Display

To create the actual wax museum within our classroom, your child will need to create a display. He/she will be creating the display with a large sheet of butcher paper. He/she will fill the paper with the name of their historical figure, year of birth to the year of death, photos they find online, and drawings or images associated with their person. This will be the backdrop they stand in front of during their presentation. Almost all of this will be done at school.

The Costume

Your child will also need to create a costume they can dress in to make their figure "come to life." Please brainstorm with your child with ideas for a costume for his/her character. Since not many families have a spare trunk of historical clothing or is an expert seamstress, your child can rely heavily on props to help represent their figure. For example, with a pair of goggles, a leather jacket, and a white scarf, you have an instant Wright brother. However, this project can certainly be completed without the use of costumes if you can't find one..
