- Use font size 10 or 12

#### Pages 4 & 5 - Personal Essay

- A personal statement/essay typed, double-spaced, at least one to two pages long.
- Ideas: Make this a special commentary illustrating what is unique about you, your family, and your
  personal and professional goals. Explain why you have chosen a particular career or vocation and
  explain your plan of pursuit. Mention your achievements, participation in school and community
  activities, and work experience. You may also mention special financial need that you may have.

#### Page 6 - Transcript

- Request a copy of your transcript from Ms. Wilcox in the counseling office
- Have it officially sealed and signed by Ms. Wilcox. You can make copies of this 1 transcript.

#### Page 7 – Financial Statement (form attached)

- Choose the top school you are presently looking at and use their information to complete this section. If you are deciding between more than one school you may put information for your top two schools.
- For Part B It is very important to only put amounts that you know **For Sure** that you will be receiving, for your **FIRST** year. Having applied to \$10,000 worth of scholarships does not mean you are receiving that amount in scholarships to put towards your first year. Don't add in amounts that are uncertain.

#### Page 8 - 10 Letters of Recommendation

- Have three letters of recommendation from adults who have been in a leadership role over you. (Teacher, principal, counselor, youth leader, pastor, coach, service project manager etc...)
- Give your recommenders <u>at least two weeks</u> to write your letter.
- Give your recommender a resume or the included letter of recommendation profile when asking them to write a letter.
