We are looking forward to another year at Kenai Middle School. Once again we have the opportunity to teach our youth in the eighth grade. It will be important that students just prior to high school establish basic study habits. Probably one of the most important and the most basic is to have the necessary supplies and to bring them to class on a regular basis.

The basic list of supplies for Origins of Democracy, 8th Grade with Mr. Summer will be:

- (1) **Spiral Notebook 100 – 120 pages** for this class only please.
(Please no “neat books” as they come apart around January or February, depending on how jammed the locker is by then)
- (2) Pens and Pencils – blue or black
- (3) Colored Pencils – for map work, etc.
- (4) Hi-Lighter Marker *A 3-ring binder to organize all classes may be very helpful.

The basic list of supplies for Science, 8th Grade with TBA will be:

- (1) Notebook and folder just for this class
- (2) Pens and Pencils, Colored Pencils
- (3) Hi-Lighter Marker
- (4) Optional: 4 – Function Calculator

The basic list of supplies for Language Arts, 8th grade with Mrs. Moss will be:

- (1) Three ring binder just for this class (1.5 inches is adequate)
- (2) 150 Sheets College Ruled Notebook Paper (3 hole punched, not spiral bound)
- (3) Pens and Pencils
- (4) Hi-Lighter Marker

The basic list of supplies for Math 3, 8th Grade with Mrs. Rininger will be:

- 1) Spiral Notebook 100 – 120 pages just for this class
 - 2) Folder for this class only
 - 3) Pens and Pencils
 - 4) 3-5 EXPO Dry-Erase Markers
- *OPTIONAL: scientific calculator

This will be a great school year and one way to help ensure a good start is to send students with the proper materials. We hope you had an excellent summer and are ready for this last year before high school.
