Employability Skills

- Employability standards will be discussed in class, including being responsible and prepared to learn and work in class on a daily basis.
- Supplies checks will count as “employability skills” grades; missing supplies will result in a lower grade. Be prepared!
- Supplies checks will happen throughout the school year; you will know about some in advance, but they may also happen without advance notice.

Required Class Supplies

- \$10 Quest LA class fee for class projects (pay to KMS office or online)
- KMS planner with name written in permanent ink (provided by school)
- 3-ring binder (1” or larger) or LA section w/ 5 dividers in large zip binder
- 5+ index dividers with tabs (manila, plastic, or cardstock, with or without pockets)
- loose-leaf lined notebook paper (about 20 sheets to start with)
- mechanical or wood pencils (with erasers, extra lead)
- ink pens (dark blue/black ink, plus other colors for editing & correcting papers)
- highlighters (at least 2 different colors)
- 10 blank envelopes & 10 “forever” postage stamps (for mailing personal letters)
- online access to PowerSchool & Google (Classroom, Docs, Slides, school Gmail)

Recommended Items

- one box of Kleenex-brand tissues (donate for class use)
- zipper pouch for small class supplies (small case in binder or larger case)
- sticky notes (for reading and research)
- USB thumb drive (for larger audio/video files)
- college dictionary & thesaurus (Merriam-Webster also available online)
- art supplies, such as colored pencils, gel pens, Sharpies, small scissors, markers, glue stick, etc. (basic art supplies are provided in class)
- letter-writing supplies (notecards, stationery, envelopes, stickers, etc.)
