JOB QUALIFICATIONS: To apply a candidate must have or be eligible to obtain a current Alaska Teacher Certificate with an endorsement in Aleut Language/Culture issued by the Alaska Department of Education on/or before the first contract day. Must be fluent in spoken and written Sugt'stun, able to apply the Alaska Cultural Standards in teaching, and be experienced in language acquisition techniques and bilingual education. Must have experience with or willingness to co-teach and share students with other colleagues in the building and integrate Sugt'stun in curricular areas to provide instruction in a collaborative atmosphere. Must be willing to collaborate successfully with colleagues in a professional learning community, and pursue opportunities for additional training. Applicant needs practical knowledge of interdisciplinary approaches and differentiated instruction, and successful use in varied cultural settings.

JOB DESCRIPTION: Teacher will teach Sugt'stun classes for K-12 students. Instruction will be delivered to multi-graded classes. Must co-teach with teachers in other curricular areas to provide Sugt'stun instruction in content areas. Will be responsible for teaching both oral and written Sugt'stun using best practices for bilingual education. Will provide instruction in Sug'piak culture as part of the language curriculum. Must have good computer skills, have a working knowledge and understanding of thematic teaching, and use varied teaching methods and differentiated instruction. Must be willing to be involved with a highly collaborative staff, work on committees, engage in activities and district sponsored programs. Other duties as assigned. School is fly-in by small airplane (4-6 passengers weather permitting). Must be motivated and capable of meeting the demands of the village lifestyle.

CERTIFICATION & HIGHLY QUALIFIED REQUIREMENTS: Must have a current Alaska Teacher Certificate with an endorsement in Aleut Language/Culture issued by the Alaska Department of Education on/or before the first contract day.

Language Skills: Ability to read, analyze and interpret professional journals, technical procedures or governmental regulations. Ability to write reports, business correspondence, and procedure manuals. Ability to effectively present information and respond to questions from groups of administrators, staff, parents and the general public.

Mathematical Skills: Ability to work with and apply mathematical concepts such as fractions, percentages, ratios, and proportions to practical situations.

Reasoning Ability: Ability to solve practical problems and deal with a variety of concrete variables in situations where only limited standardization exists. Ability to interpret a variety of instructions furnished in written, oral, diagram, or schedule form.

Other Skills and Abilities: Ability to apply knowledge of current research and theory to instructional program; ability to plan and implement lessons based on division and school objectives and the needs and abilities of students to whom assigned. Ability to establish and maintain effective relationships with students, peers and parents; skill in oral and written communication. Ability to perform duties with awareness of all district requirements and Board of Education policies.

Physical Demands: While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to stand and talk or hear and sometimes walk and sit. While performing the duties of this job, the employee may occasionally push or lift up to 50 lbs. such as boxes of books and AV/VCR carts. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision such as to read handwritten or typed material, and the ability to adjust focus. The position requires the individual to meet multiple demands from several people and interact with the public and other staff. Person must be able to frequently traverse rough terrain in course of fulfilling professional duties.
