## **Attn: Middle School Mass Choir**

Dear Parents and Choir Members,

The Middle School Mass Choir is coming up soon and so I wanted to share with you some details regarding this event.

### **What is a Mass Choir?**

It is a unique collaborative event put on the KPBSD where multiple school choirs come together to share their collective interest in music. After preparing pieces in class, we will meet for a one-day event where we rehearse and then perform as one massive choir in the evening.

### **Date and Times for Mass Choir?**

Tuesday, April 11, 2023, at Kenai Central High School

Rehearsal: During the school day

Concert: doors open at 5:30 pm and starts at 6:00 pm

General admission: Adults - \$5.00, Senior Citizens - \$3.00, Students - \$2.00,  
Family - \$15.00

Students will be bussed beginning of the school day and taken to KCHS for rehearsal during the school day. There will be a break between the end of rehearsal and the start of the concert. Students will stay at KCHS during this time. They will be able to meet new friends, hang out, or do schoolwork. Students will then dress in concert attire and perform in the concert that evening. A detailed schedule and meal arrangements will be provided closer to the event.

### **What do I need to wear for this event/ Concert Attire?**

For this Borough event, we will be wearing the school choir robes. All shoes and under-robe garments should be black when possible. Women should not wear heels that are uncomfortable to stand in for long periods or hard to balance on the risers.
