- KPBSD budget- safe harbor helps our district since we are below 23% for our enrollment. Federal money is possibly going to be a positive impact for our school district. Things are looking positive! The board is looking to stabilize and secure staffing. March 23<sup>rd</sup> is the next budget meeting for the Central Peninsula.
- October 1<sup>st</sup> is the enrollment is what we base next year's teachers on, and we had 204 students. The school board might consider our April enrollment for next year instead.
- Staffing- NNS is slated to lose 5 teachers at this time.
- Pre-K / Title 1 for NNS- 49% of our students qualify for free and reduced lunches. This has funded 2 teachers through the title 1 program for 12 years. Our title 1 moneys will be cut for next year. We will have 1 position for NNS next year and we will decide how our title 1 money will be used.
