Math

I have to introduce new concepts in both grades and move forward. In 2nd grade: we are focusing on addition with regrouping. In 3rd grade, we are working on subtractions and will move toward multiplication. I will send manipulatives home for multiplication as the children need to understand the process of grouping.

Reading
