3) Title I Committee Meeting

- *Title 1 is sending a take-home backpack with books and activities as well as guided reading videos daily. Covered Title 1 engagement policy key points. Will try a family engagement event in the spring since we can't do that now. Reviewed early literacy percentile scores and what we look at for Title 1 intervention support as well as why*

4) Health Update

- *We are in the Southern Peninsula with currently 103 cases. Highly recommend testing with any cold like symptoms. District is updating the district wide smart plan. Nurse Melisa-isolating for 10 days after a positive because that is when it is most infectious, sheds after that. If you get a positive you do not have to get another test, socially distance, or not travel for 90 days. Cohorting and school mitigation has worked very well especially in Raz.*

5) Mitigation Plan Update

- *New mitigation plan is still under review. Family cohorts and am/pm groups in the old plan worked well. The new plan would be similar to the old. Each am/pm group would be divided into 2 groups. Groups will still be organized by families. The whole idea of this plan is to be able to introduce new material to students due to lack of internet access and difficulty completing Student Packets.*

6) Other (continued...)

- *Parent asked KPBSD Board Member Zen Kelly, "How can we get our school open...because looking at the cases, if our school is part of Fritz Creek area, we have very little cases out here. The mitigation plan...how can we get it to go a little bit faster for approval?" Zen responded by first referencing last month's Board Meeting on Nov. 2nd, when the Board asked District Administration to come up with additional mitigations that will return students to in-school instruction during Red Risk Levels. Zen then cited this decision had occurred before the current upward trends (high rates & numbers) started happening. At that time, the Board was figuring out ways to modify the thresholds...but then cited that cases had then escalated at a rapid rate. Zen next cited that it's very difficult to have data that separates Russian villages from Fritz Creek and Homer with the current reporting which the Board receives. There are different data sources that affect decisions, and pointed out that Fritz Creek and HOB villages are connected to Homer, and that HOB villages are considered Southern Peninsula. To answer the question how to approve the mitigation plan more quickly, District Administration is working on plans on how to allow students back to class, but cited uncertainty based off current COVID numbers and rates. Zen cited a need to bring the infection rates down. Zen also referenced the upcoming Board Meeting on Dec 7th, where updated district mitigation plans will be presented and reviewed in lieu of current thresholds. Zen acknowledged that his response doesn't fully answer the question, and cited concerns that he doesn't want schools to contribute to transmission rate.*
- *An attending school teacher asked Zen Kelly if he could provide when/where the meeting will take place, citing that a number of families have posed the question to him. Zen responded by saying that while it'll take place at Kenai Central High auditorium on Dec. 7th at 6pm, there will be no physical public presence. However, the public can attend by phone or online. Info on participating will be sent to families when the time draws closer.*
