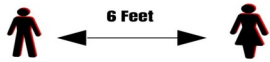

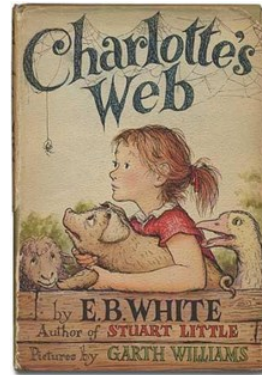

A.M. Pre-K students will come to school at their normal time and will participate in the round up, then return to class. All A.M. Pre-K parents are invited to attend the parent session from 9:30-10:30.

P.M. Pre-K students can come for the round up from 9:30-10:30 (parents attend as well), and then they will return for their PM Pre-K session at their normal time.

Our current kindergarten students will have a delayed start in order to accommodate kindergarten round up. Our current kindergarten students will come to school at 11:00, drop their items at their spot in the hallway, and go to recess outside.
