

You will receive a phone call and a **screening appointment** will be made when your application is received by the school. Although all children benefit from a PRE-K program space is limited to 20 children. Priority is based on information obtained at the screening appointment. You will be contacted by the Pre-K teacher after the screening to let you know your child's status for entry. Transportation is not provided to or from the Pre-K program. Students must be 4 years old by September 1, 2021.
