Dear Redoubt Parents,



CLOTHING, COLD WEATHER, AND OUTDOOR RECESS

Students should come to school dressed for the weather and prepared to go outside. All children go outside for recess until the chill factor temperature is minus 10 degrees Fahrenheit. Generally, any child well enough to come to school is well enough to go outside for recess. Even shortened recesses give the children a much-needed break in routine and fresh air. A child too sick to go outside should be recuperating at home. When special circumstances exist, students may be allowed to remain indoors for recess with a doctor's note. Please contact the school nurse to make arrangements. Boots are essential for outdoor recess. A pair of shoes should be kept at school to wear inside the building.

Sitting with boots on all day is not healthy for feet. Students should have a heavy, winter weight coat, snow pants or a snowsuit, warm hat or hood, winter boots, and gloves or mittens.
