What is PBIS? POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTIONS
AND SUPPORT.

This is an intervention and support program that works to improve student behavior. Our students earn compliments for being:

Responsible, Respectful, Safe and Kind. Each compliment, individually for a student or as a class, is added to their class "compliment jar". Once this jar is full they earn a class reward and their class is named in the morning announcements.

With this program we hope to increase academic performance while keeping our students safe and rewarding them for good behavior.
