High Risk COVID-19 School Update

34 KPBSD schools will operate with REMOTE LEARNING through December 18, 2020

- Onsite learning option in High-Risk will resume for Pre-K, K, and Intensive Needs students on Wednesday, December 2, 2020 (On November 12, Governor Dunbar asked Alaskans to sacrifice and change their daily routines for three weeks. In response, KPBSD shifted to 100% remote for all grades and students).
- Free Get-It-And-Go Meals for students can be picked up daily between 12:00-1:00. Order by noon on Friday.
- A SmartStart plan update so more students could attend school onsite during High Risk operations will be presented to the KPBSD Board of Education on December 7, 2020.
