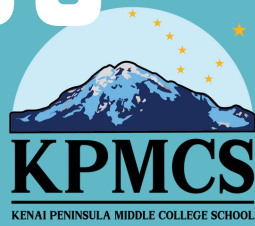

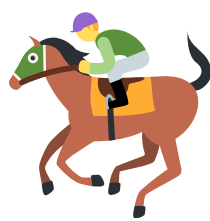
Get Ready! Get Set! GGGOOO!!
