Free and Reduced Program

Online Application: Parents or guardians must reapply each year for free or reduced meal benefits. All applications will be accepted online through the new state portal at mealapp.kpbsd.org. If someone does not have access to the internet, we have a few paper applications in our school office, or you can stop by the Student Nutrition Services office. The grace period for families that haven't filled out their 24/25 application ends on October 2nd, 2024.

Opt-In form required to charge up to two days of meals: Students will not be permitted to charge any meals until parents or guardians have signed an Opt-In form for their child. The Opt-In is included in the online packet, and SNS needs a form completed for each student that a parent gives permission to charge. When completed, students will be allowed to charge up to two days of meals, and no further charges will be allowed until the amount is paid back.

STEP 1: Before Parents/Guardian's set up an observer account through Gradient Learning you will need to have your child send you a pairing code. These pairing codes can only be found so far through the student's profile in their settings menu. We are trying to come up with a better system but we appreciate your patience. If at anytime you need assistance with having your child sent a pairing code you can email your students mentor or contact the RCA Office.

Tip: If you have computer and internet access at home you can have your student login through the Gradient Learning website and send you a pairing code as you are setting your observer account at the same time. These codes are only good for 7 days before they expire, so please make sure to link your observer account within those 7 days.
