

2022/2023 High School Senior Tuition Scholarship

Opens: October 1st - Closes March 17,2022; 5 pm

GENERAL INFORMATION. Kenai Peninsula College is offering several tuition scholarships to graduating seniors from the following schools: Kenai Central High School, Soldotna High School, Kenai Alternative High School, River City Academy, Cook Inlet Academy, Nikiski High School, Ninilchik High School, Seward High School, Cooper Landing and Hope Schools, and Kenai Peninsula Borough residents participating in home-school programs. This scholarship may be used for attendance during the 2022/2023 academic year at Kenai Peninsula College's, Kenai River Campus (Soldotna) or at our Resurrection Bay Extension Site (Seward).

Chosen recipients may be awarded up to twelve (12) Kenai River Campus credits of tuition waived for the fall and spring semesters of the 2022/2023 academic year; the student is responsible for all other UA campus tuition, any required books, supplies, and all fees.

Applicants are advised to fill out the 2022/2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to assist the Scholarship Committee in determining financial need. Applicants who have not completed the FAFSA by the review date may not be considered for this scholarship should financial need become a determining factor in the committee's decision. See your high school counselor or call the KPC Financial Aid Office for additional information or assistance with filing the FAFSA by the deadline (907-262-0332).

TO APPLY, STUDENTS MUST:

- Have been an Alaska resident for the past 12 months.
- Complete the attached application cover sheet.
- Complete the 2022/2023 FAFSA (www.fafsa.gov).
- Attach a high school transcript (signed by authorized personnel) showing a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- Attach no more than a one page, typed statement describing career goals and educational plans, as well as any volunteer work you have performed. This is your only opportunity to explain what a wonderful candidate you are. Believe in yourself and remember to use "SPELL CHECK"!
- Submit two letters of reference, one from a faculty or staff member at the high school you attend, and one from a member of the community.

All application packets must be received complete via email, US mail, or in person by the Financial Aid Office at KPC's Kenai River Campus by 5 PM. The KPC Financial Aid Office email is kpc.financial.aid@alaska.edu.
