Meet the Level 1 criteria for the Alaska Performance Scholarship

Math and Science Curriculum

- 4 credits KPBSD Alaska Performance Scholarship approved math
- 4 credits KPBSD Alaska Performance Scholarship approved science
- 4 credits KPBSD Alaska Performance Scholarship approved English/Language Arts

Social Studies and Language Curriculum

- 2 credits KPBSD Alaska Performance Scholarship approved world language
- 3 credits KPBSD Alaska Performance Scholarship approved math
- 4 credits KPBSD Alaska Performance Scholarship approved English/Language Arts
- 4 credits KPBSD Alaska Performance Scholarship approved social studies

Minimum GPA of 3.50

AND

25 ACT

OR

1210 SAT

OR

13 WorkKeys (no score below 4)

AND

- One performance class (e.g. choir, drama, student council) OR participation in a performance co-curricular activity (e.g. Debate, NOSB, Battle of the Books).
- 100 cumulative hours of service learning with a pre-approved community based organization. (Documented and turned in on the school form).
- In addition, the student must write an essay that describes the service learning, the benefit to the community, and the benefit to the student.
