Seahawk Parents, we will be practicing a "Safety Closure" drill on, Tuesday May 3, 2022 @ 9:35am using the A.L.I.C.E. protocols. Teachers will be working with their students prior to this drill.

In order to give our staff and students more option to protect themselves, KPBSD adopted the A.L.I.C.E. protocols to be used when the presence of a violent intruder necessitates a "Safety Closure." A.L.I.C.E. is an acronym for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, and Evacuate. These protocols are age appropriate, not sequential or chronological, and those involved have the ability to change protocols as an incident develops.

I have attached KPBSD Emergency Guidelines for Parents and Guardians. Please review it so that you will know what to do if there is a school emergency situation.
