

QNT Scholarship Program Policy

I. GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION:

The purpose of this policy is to set forth procedures and requirements to govern the awarding of tribal scholarships as administered by the Qutekcak Native Tribe (QNT).

- The QNT's scholarship program is designed to encourage post-secondary education and career development;
- The QNT's Council administers the scholarship program and all decisions are final;
- The program is for the specific purpose of financially assisting eligible applicants who
 are enrolled in an accredited university, college or trade school and are pursuing a
 degree/certificate on a full time basis;
- Students attending school less than full time (as determined by your school) or pursuing a
 course in a trade or vocational school may be eligible for reduced scholarship amounts;
- QNT will accept scholarship applications anytime but will make scholarship awards in September and February of each year depending on funding;
- Funding for the program comes from the Scholarship Auction (pot luck) held each spring and donations and other funds received throughout the year;
- The total amount of funds received and/or raised during the preceding year will determine the amount of scholarships awarded.

II. ELIGIBILITY:

- To be considered for the tribal scholarship program students must be a tribal member of QNT and exercise their right of self-determination by voting in every tribal election they are qualified to vote in before and during the time they receive a scholarship award;
- Additionally, one community-at-large member will be awarded an annual scholarship at the Seward High School Graduation in May of each year;
- All scholarships (tribal and community) will be competitive, based on: past and current grade point average (GPA), type of school program pursuing, and length of program.

III. STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY:

You have the primary responsibility to obtain funding for your education. You will need to save money for transportation and miscellaneous costs that you may incur before you enroll in college. To be successful, you must take care to insure that you have enough money to meet your expenses. We do have staff that may be able to refer you to additional scholarships. Please call our office should you need resources.

- Contact your school's financial aid office once notified of an award as the funds will be forwarded to the Registrar/Financial Aid Office at your school of choice and they will credit the funds towards your expenses;
- Scholarships will not be awarded to students on academic probation, so you must maintain a 2.0 grade point average, or above;
- Provide official transcripts to our office at the completion of every semester;
- Notify this office of any changes in your address, contact information or plans regarding school.

IV. APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- Apply through school counselor by May 1st if you are a community member at large graduating from Seward High School;
- Tribal members, please apply through the QNT Tribal office at 221 Third Avenue, Seward, AK 99664;
- Complete the entire application making sure that all information is clearly legible;
- Include a copy of your official transcripts from the last school attended;
- New applicants should include a letter of acceptance from the school to be attended.

** Application not COMPLETELY filled out and LEGIBLE will not be considered. **
