Things to note......

Attendance:

When your child is absent they must present a satisfactory explanation verifying the reason for the absence. Notification can be done by the following methods: *Hand written note or email from parent/guardian or parent representative. *Conversation, in person or by telephone, between the verifying employee and the student's parent/guardian or parent-representative.

Please note that all absences or late arrivals will be marked as unexcused until parent/guardian notifies the office. More information can be found in the student & parent handbook. If your student is going to miss more than 3 days consecutively then they need to pick up a pre-arranged absence form from the office and have that signed off by their teachers and the principal.

PowerSchool:

PowerSchool is a great resource for parents. Here you can view your students grades, attendance, pay school fees etc. If you are having trouble logging in (and have tried to reset your password) please contact the office for assistance.

Student Fees:

All sports fees should to be paid prior to the first game/meet. Payments can be made in cash or check to the office (made out to Seward High School with a note in the memo) or via PowerSchool. CORNER

- **1.** The first SAT test offered at SHS is on Saturday, Oct. 5th. The deadline to register without a late fee is this Thursday, September 20th. September 24th is the deadline with a \$39 late fee. Students should register directly with <u>SAT CollegeBoard</u>. See Mr. Dye for more information or to discuss fee waiver eligibility.
- **2.** The PSAT/NMSQT assessment will be offered at SHS on Wednesday, Oct. 23rd, the cost is \$18.00. Sophomores and Juniors interested in taking the PSAT/NMSQT test should see Mr. Dye to register and pay the registration fee to Ms. Price. Deadline to register/pay is Friday, Sept. 13th.
- **3.** We will be offering one (1) school-day SAT test on Wednesday, Oct. 30th. Students must sign up with Mr. Dye before Friday, Sept. 13th.
- **4.** The ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) will be offered at SHS on Wednesday, Nov. 20th and Wednesday, April 16th. This free assessment is available to all 10-12th grades students. See Mr. Dye for more information or to sign up for the assessment.




Upward Bound/T3


