- **4.** We will be offering one (1) school-day SAT test on Wednesday, Oct. 30th.
- **5.** The ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) will be offered at SHS on Wednesday, Nov. 20th and Wednesday, April 16th. This free assessment is available to all 10-12th grades students. Sign up by Nov. 18 for November assessment.
- 6. SAT test Saturday Dec. 7. Register by Nov. 22. Cost is \$68.
- 7. The Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education (ACPE) has recently made significant changes to the Alaska Performance Scholarship (ACP) eligibility requirements. Seahawk Football team finished their regular season 7-0. They are moving on to state the 2nd week of October.




## **BANNED BOOK WEEK**


