1. Now is the time to start thinking about scholarships! Keep your eye on the SHS website for dates to submit applications for local scholarships. Another great resource for scholarships is **ONE Stop** by KPBSD. If you need help, call the office.
2. The first SAT test offered at SHS is on Saturday, Oct. 5th.
3. The PSAT/NMSQT assessment will be offered at SHS on Wednesday, Oct. 23rd.
4. We will be offering one (1) school-day SAT test on Wednesday, Oct. 30th.
5. The ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) will be offered at SHS on Wednesday, Nov. 20th and Wednesday, April 16th. This free assessment is available to all 10-12th grades students. Sign up by Nov. 18 for November assesment.
6. SAT test Saturday Dec. 7. Register by Nov. 22. Cost is \$68.
7. The Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education (ACPE) has recently made significant changes to the Alaska Performance Scholarship (ACP) eligibility requirements. I suggest students and parents/guardians review new eligibility requirements at <https://acpe.alaska.gov/FINANCIAL-AID/AK-Performance-Scholarship>

8. KPBSD is now utilizing a new platform called, Naviance: Career Planning – Exploration and Assessment, for students in grades 6-12 to provide post-secondary educational and career planning. More information will follow.
