



Students need to be prepared to turn in textbooks, chargers, library books and Chromebooks. You will be charged for any missing items that have been checked out to you.




Awards NIGHT

Congratulations Hannah Leatherman for winning the Caring for the Kenai contest. She is the first student from Seward to win the contest in the 35 years the competition has been taking place.


