Thank you for your interest in the Kawabe Memorial Fund scholarship.

The Kawabe Memorial Fund was established in 1971 by the will of Harry S. Kawabe to support and promote general operations and programs of nonprofit agencies devoted to the care of low-income children, families and seniors in the Puget Sound area. The Fund also provides higher education scholarships to students graduating from Seward High School, as well as occasional capital project grants to churches or scholarships for training teachers, priests and ministers. ***Students planning to attend an Alaska vocational technical school are encouraged to apply.***

Eleven people serve on the Kawabe Memorial Fund Committee to direct the distribution of grants and scholarships from the Fund. A Scholarship Committee reviews scholarship applications from students and makes recommendations for awards to the broader committee. Scholarships are evaluated based on life aspirations including how students will contribute to the Seward community and their financial need.
