- Registration fees (excluding Saturday SAT tests) are payable to Seward High School, given to Ms. Price, before the registration deadline.

The SAT test is a standardized test widely used for college admissions and scholarships (including the Alaska Performance Scholarship). Juniors, and especially Seniors, should seriously consider taking the SAT test.

The PSAT/NMSQT assessment (Practice SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) is for 10th and 11th grade students. For 10th grade students, the assessment is basically a practice SAT test. For 11th grade students, the score is used to possibly qualify for the National Merit Scholarship.
