Old Business:

Dress Code: Review of staff survey regarding our current dress code and areas where staff felt we needed to review for potential changes. The majority of staff agreed that the policy should remain unchanged with the exception of the following section:

Shorts and/or miniskirts (including any side slit) that end more than four inches above the kneecap while standing upright are inappropriate for school. Pants with holes or slits in them that are four or more inches above the kneecap are also inappropriate for school.
