Old Business:

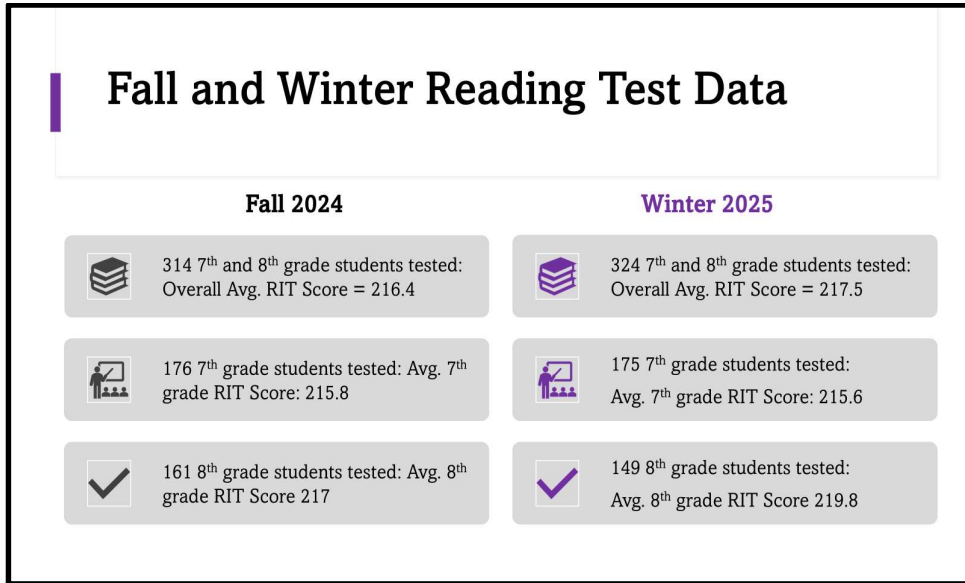

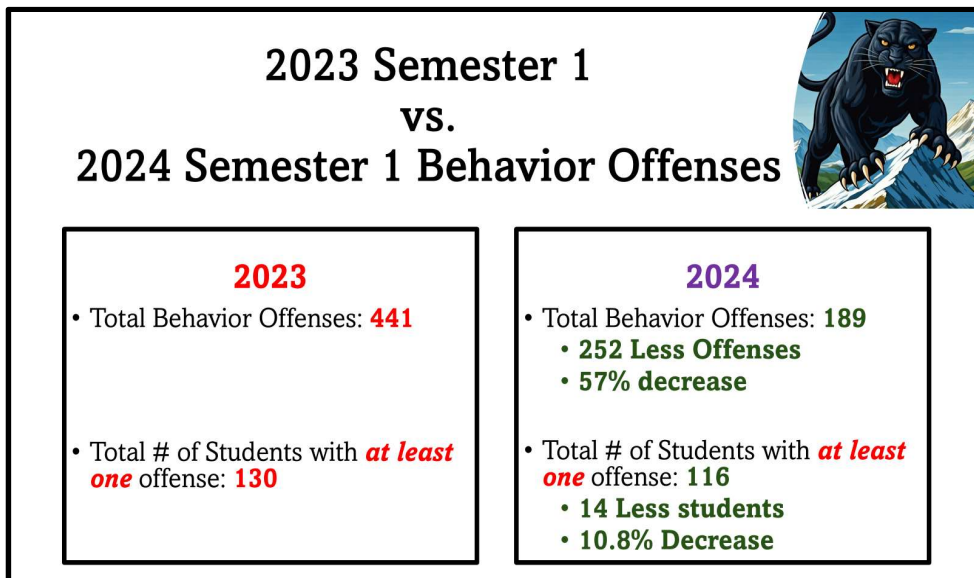
