Greetings,

We are working on learning about the Zones of Regulation. From this lesson, students are learning how to identify which zone their emotions are in. Each zone consists of four colors: blue, green, yellow and red. When we are in the blue zone, we may be feeling: sad, sick, tired, bored or we may be moving slowly. When we are in the green zone, we may be feeling: calm, happy, focused and ready to learn. When we are in the yellow zone, we may be feeling: anxious, silly, frustrated, excited, scared or worried. When we are in the red zone, we may be feeling: angry, yelling, mean, out of control or we may need time and space.

Students are learning to be emotion detectives so that they can identify why they are in a particular zone. As an outcome of this lesson, the goal is to equip students with coping strategies to reset and regulate their emotions for learning. I have included links that help explain Zones of Regulation as well as provide learning materials that can be used at home. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
