Building Access Changes

With the new district-mandated policy of elementary schools locking the front door, we are working through options to ease parent access during the school day after front door drop off., and the front door is locked. SMCS/SOEL are part of 6 schools piloting the use of the buzz in system for the school doors.

A challenge to this work is providing buzz-in for two schools with one front door buzzer. This option is not possible with this system. A different solution for us (this plan has NOT been finalized) is that SMCS has a rear door access panel that includes a camera and a buzz in button (the button is not yet functional); the district is requesting us to use this rear door for parent admission for students arriving after 8:50 at that time the front doors lock.

We will be marking SMCS visitor parking areas in the back lot for our parents that visit during the school day. These changes will occur over the next week. We are asking all families to use the back parking lot and rear-door entry beginning next week. At this time, a call to our office will still be necessary to notify us of your arrival, until we get a buzz in button functional.

Please do not use the front door after 8:50. We will still use the front of the school for drop-off and pick-up: this change is only for the times between 8:50 and 3:30. This will take some time to establish consistent practice for families, but we feel this will ultimately help ease parent access and make visits feel more welcoming.
