We will not be sending home Thursday folders next week due to conferences.

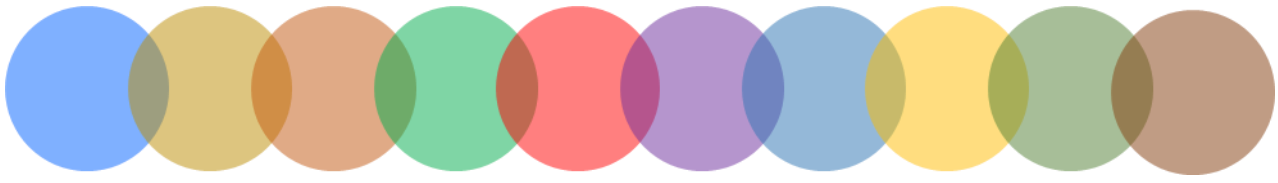
