Information.

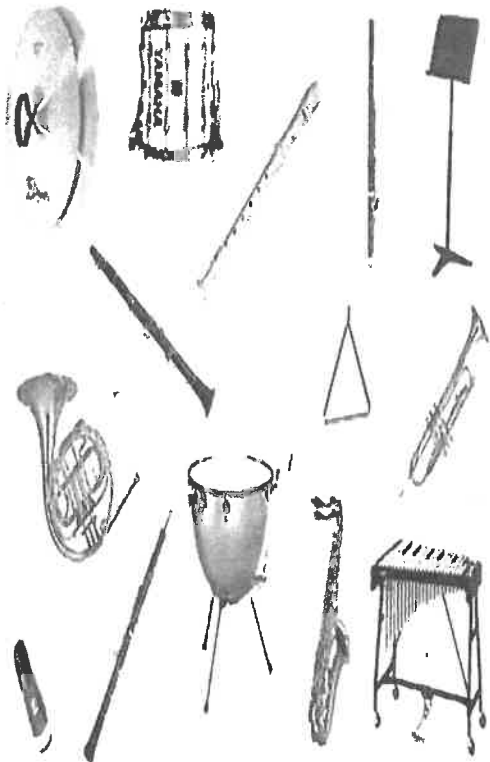
Concert Band is open to fourth, fifth and sixth graders. For more Information about band, or
